'Shot on iPhone Challenge' is a photo contest launched by Apple on January 22, to find the photos taken with the most beautiful iPhone in the world.

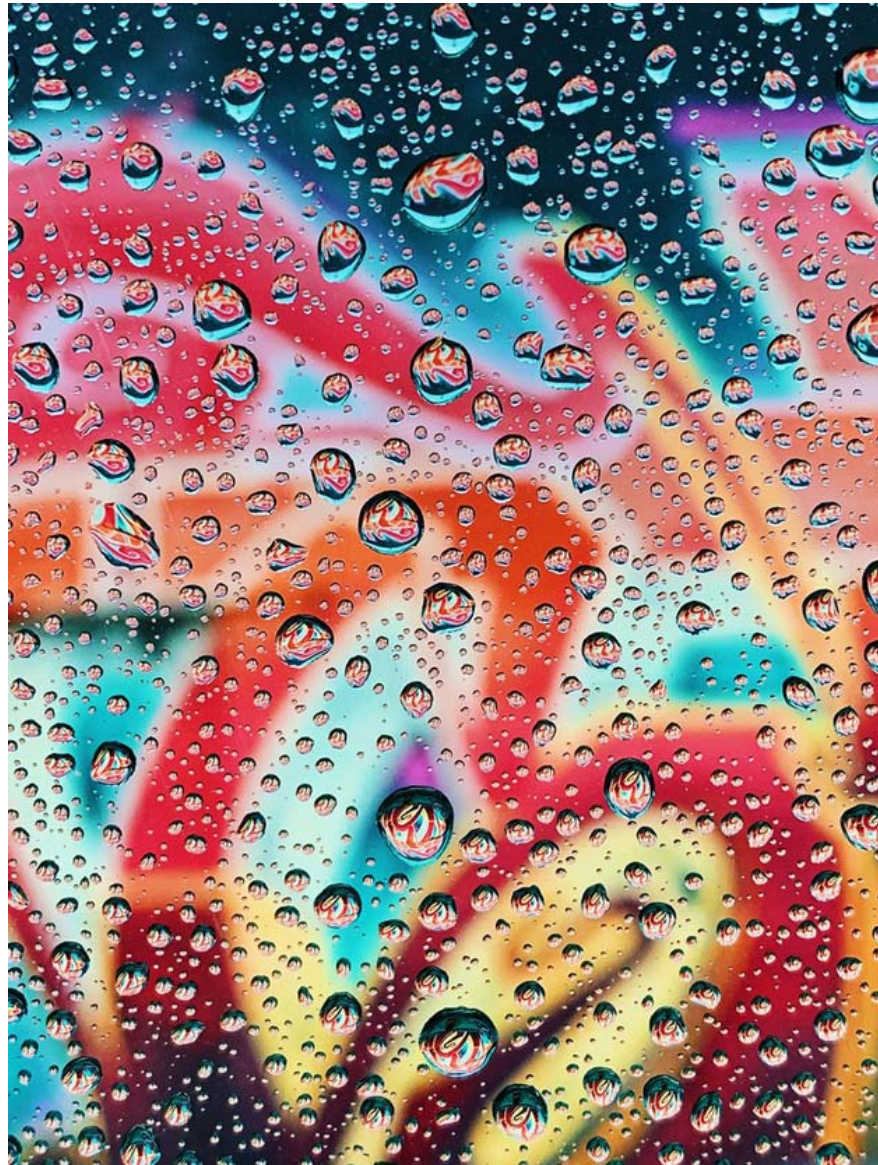

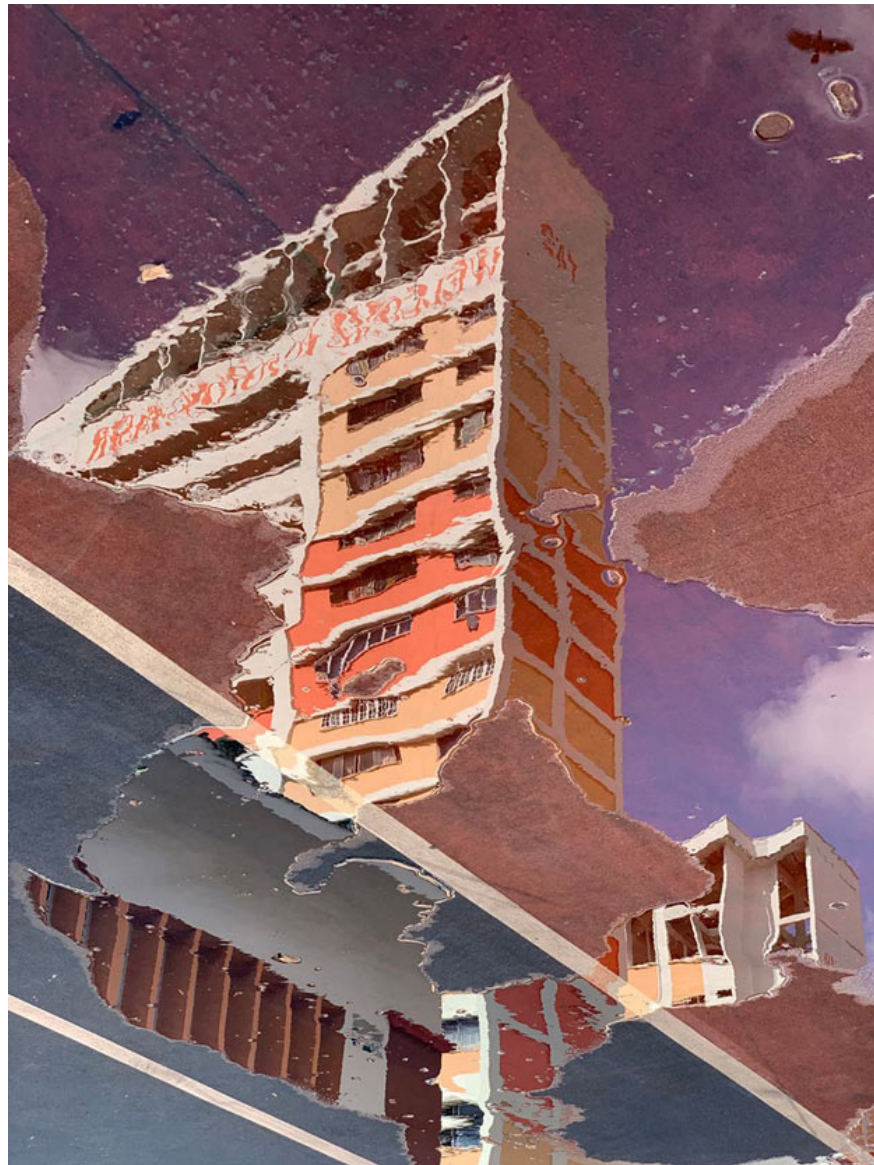

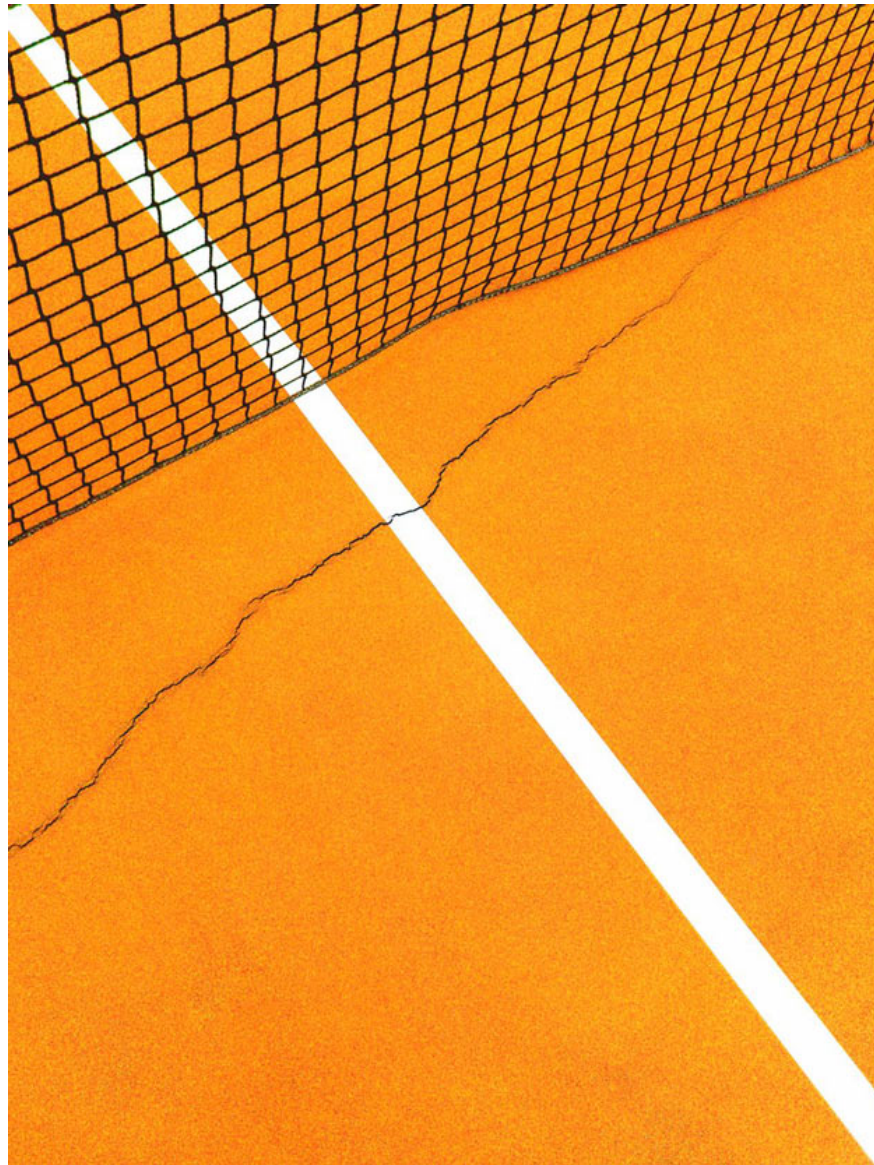
