Some of Apple's general recruitment requirements for candidates are 3-5 years of experience in the position, apply for teamwork, communication, working in English (know Korean). , Chinese language will be an advantage), understanding Vietnamese culture, market .

In the job description, Apple said that vacancies in Vietnam will participate in the product development process, working with partners to ensure supply .

The recent publication of Apple job postings in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City has made many people think that this could be a sign that the technology giant is speeding up its plan to shift production to China. Last year, Nikkei revealed that Apple wants to accelerate its plans to diversify where consumer electronics are made, not just in China as it is, and Apple is set to start testing wireless headsets. (Airpod) in Vietnam.
