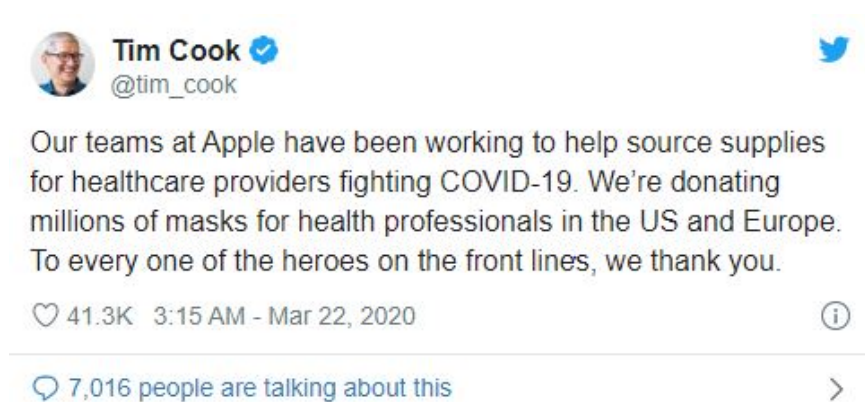


Apple has donated numerous medical masks to the US and Europe to help combat the Covid-19 pandemic.

We will donate millions of masks to health professionals in both the US and Europe. We thank them - the heroes who are at the forefront of this battle . '*



CEO Tim Cook said that Apple has been actively supporting medical teams in the battle against Covid-19, and also not forgetting the silent heroes of humanity.

Earlier, Bloomberg also confirmed that a number of TV programs around medical topics such as Gray's Anatomy or The Good Doctor have supported many more masks, gloves, and protective gear in the past week. Because the film and television industry is stagnant, a series of film projects have been temporarily discontinued, so they don't need these items.

This is not the first time Apple has supported the world in the prevention of the Covid-19 pandemic. CEO Tim Cook has revealed that Apple has donated \$ 15 million to the companies most affected by the pandemic, especially in Italy. The money will be used to treat coronavirus-positive victims, support doctors, nurses and volunteers who are operating at full capacity regardless of the day and night to push back. Disease. In addition, Apple also donated a large amount of money to Silicon Valley Strong, a newly formed organization in the San Francisco Bay Area with the purpose of supporting families and small businesses affected by Covid-19.

Up to now, the world has recorded more than 300,000 cases of SARS-CoV-2, nearly 13,000 deaths (according to statistics from Johns Hopkins University). In the US alone, the numbers are 24,100 and 285, respectively. To limit the spread in the community, Apple has announced the closure of all its branch stores worldwide until March 27, except in china. In addition, the tech giant has canceled some of its major events, including WWDC 2020), moving to online activities to ensure the health and safety of both employees and customers.
