Trojans were distributed under Apple's fake sales notification emails, which reported that users were sent a digital music product, and because they would be charged \$ 479.95 to the account. account



E-mail on enticing users to open an attachment named **OrderInf.zip** and run the **OrderInfo.exe** file. Just click on this file, **Troj / Downdec-A** will immediately be executed and then download malicious code to the victim machine.
