

Apple launches iOS 19 update with codename 'Luck'

On schedule, Bloomberg reports that Apple has begun development on iOS 19, macOS 16, watchOS 12, and VisionOS 3 for next year.

In the latest edition of the Power On newsletter, Mark Gurman reports that Apple has '*officially begun work on 2025's major operating systems*'. While this may seem early, Gurman notes that this is a typical schedule for Apple's software development timelines.

1. iOS 19: 'Luck'
2. macOS 16: 'Cheer'
3. watchOS 12: 'Nepali'
4. visionOS 3: 'Discovery'

However, it's still too early to know anything about Apple's plans for software updates next year.

The company has officially launched the main operating systems of 2025: iOS 19 ('Luck'), macOS 16 ('Cheer'), watchOS 12 ('Nepali'), and VisionOS 3 ('Discovery'). It's still too early to predict anything now. After all, this year's software series has not yet been released to the public. But here's the usual schedule: The company is developing next year's hardware products and needs accompanying software to begin testing the devices.
