

Apple may launch MacBook 5G connected by 2020

According to DigiTimes, Apple is trying to release MacBook 5G connectivity by 2020, with fast and stable connection speeds.

After the successful acquisition of modem manufacturing business of Intel, Apple is implementing a lot of 5G network technology research plans for its products. As analyst Ming-Chi Kuo predicts, Apple will integrate 5G networks for all iPhone versions in 2020. And according to DigiTimes, Apple is deploying a plan to integrate 5G connectivity for MacBook models. .

5G technology began to emerge around mid-2019, with the launch of 5G mobile phones, notebooks, and devices. With the MacBook 5G, Apple plans to introduce the technology to the industry in the second quarter of 2020.

To broadcast a 5G network, the MacBook's 5G antenna is made of ceramic instead of metal like rivals. Thus the access speed as well as the coverage area is significantly improved. Besides, the MacBook 5G will use ARM processor chips that Apple is developing specifically for notebooks.



Therefore, the price of MacBook 5G is not cheap at all, because ceramic modems cost 5-6 times more than ordinary metal. Currently the 16-inch MacBook Pro version costs about 3000 USD. If the MacBook 5G launches successfully, the amount of money users pay will certainly exceed \$ 300. The future of the MacBook 5G, please wait for the official announcement of Apple.
