The new MacBook Air may launch next month.

Appleinsider sources recently said large online retailers like MacConnection are no longer popular MacBook Air models like the 13.3-inch model with 1.8 GHz processor and 256 GB SSD. Best Buy, despite being advertised with stock, is limited.

Usually, the decline in stock of authorized dealers from Apple is a sign that a new product is coming soon.

Not much is known about **the 2013 MacBook Air**, but *Cnet* predicts it will use Intel's new chip. The manufacturer will release **Haswell processor** in **early June** with improved speed, power consumption and graphics power.

Apple's WWDC conference will take place a few days after Intel launched Haswell, where many experts predict the new MacBook Air will appear.

Not much is known about the specifications of the new MacBook Air. Many users expect it to be a Retina super high resolution, but this upgrade seems impossible, because it will create competition among products in Apple's

existing Mac line. In addition, high-definition screens also consume quite a lot of batteries, requiring strong configuration and excessive heat, details that make thin production difficult.
