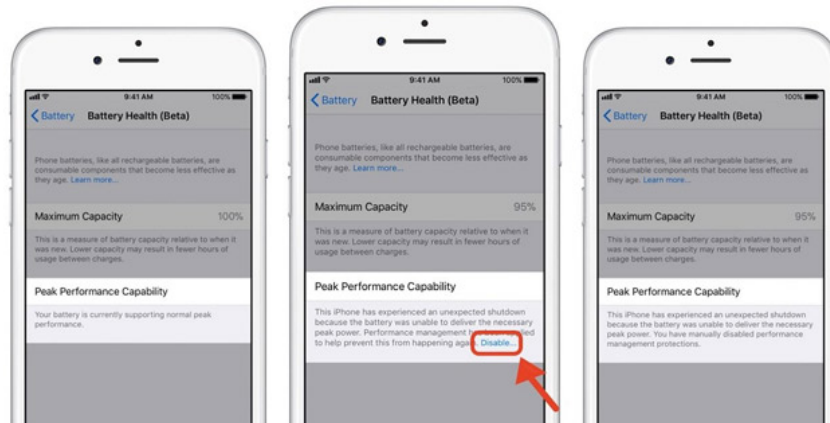


Apple officially released iOS 11.3, allowing to turn off the device when the battery is slow

The official iOS 11.3 update has been released, now you can proceed to upgrade iOS 11.3 via OTA.

After many days of waiting, Apple finally officially released iOS 11.3 version for all compatible devices to better support users in the process of using the device. You can now upgrade iOS 11.3 via OTA.

In this update, "apple house" brings many interesting enhancements to the new Animoji, improves the device's AR functions, complements Health Records in the health care application to help patients at over 40 Health facilities can view their medical records (including Duke, Yale, Stanford, NYO Langone), . and especially the feature to turn off automatic mode to reduce performance when the battery is reduced in life expectancy. below allowable levels on iPhone 6, 6 Plus, SE, 6s, 6s Plus, 7 and 7 Plus. Reportedly, the first official update was released via OTA on March 30th at 0 am, devices that support upgrades include: iPhone, iPod Touch and iPad. To update to iOS 11.3, go to *Settings > General Settings > Software update* to proceed to download and upgrade the device.
