New features stand out on iOS 12.4

1. During the setup process, users can directly transfer data from the old iPhone to the new device by moving the iPhone.
2. In Apple News (available in certain countries only): Adds the deleted journal delete feature (History -> Delete -> Delete all), adds publications in Apple News +, accesses (both offline and online) on the content downloaded in my Magazine section.
3. Fix security issues for Push to Talk app on Apple Watch and re-enable Push to talk feature.



To update to iOS 12.4 for Phone / iPad via OTA, you go to Settings (Settings) -> select General Settings (General) -> select Software Update (Software Update).

For Apple Watch, to update to watchOS version 5.3 via OTA, you access the Clock Application (Watch on iPhone) -> select General Settings (General) -> select Software update (Software Update) .
