Although Apple never points out the level of danger from security flaws in its products, as Microsoft often does, security company Secunia has also classified some security flaws in the Mac operating system. OS X 10.3.9 and 10.4.2 and 'very serious' rankings only after the most dangerous level is 'extremely serious'.

A total of 43 security flaws were patched by Apple this time with all kinds of errors such as web browser errors, system access errors, buffer overflow errors, data disclosure errors, and many data processing errors. data as well as other security .
