According to *AppleInsider* , Apple will postpone the launch of the new Macbook Air using Sandy Bridge processors until Mac OS X Lion is completed.

The new generation of iPhone and iPod Touch was only released after iOS 5 and iCloud service ready to market. iPhone 5 phones are expected to be "*released* " in the third quarter of this year.

According to *AppleInsider*, the new generation of Macbook Air has integrated Thunderbolt high-speed connector ready for mass production. But because Apple wants to focus on Mac OS X Lion operating system, Apple decided to move the launch date of Macbook Air after June.

The source also said " *Apple* " will start mass production when the new Macbook Air can run stably on Mac OS X Gold Master version for developers including some free iCloud services. attached.

Mac mini products come with Thunderbolt ports and LED screens will also be introduced after Lion's completion. AppleInsider said, " *Apple*" only considers the launch of these products before Lion and iCloud services when there are some issues at issue that affect the company's finances.
