Apple has just released the next update of Mac OS X, version 10.9.2, to address the security vulnerability it admitted a long time ago.

Accordingly, the version of Mac OS X 10.9.2 will focus on resolving some of the existing bugs. Most notable is the " *Gotofail* " security error. This vulnerability relates to the SSL / TLS connection - the system that creates a secure link between the computer and the server - has received the concern of security experts since it was discovered and fixed on iOS. last week.

The 10.9.2 update is recommended for all OS X Mavericks users and contains improvements to the stability, compatibility and security of your Mac.

This update:

- Adds the ability to make and receive FaceTime audio calls
- Adds call waiting support for FaceTime audio and video calls
- Adds the ability to block incoming iMessages from individual senders
- Improves the accuracy of unread counts in Mail
- Resolves an issue that prevented Mail from receiving new messages from certain providers
- Improves AutoFill compatibility in Safari
- Fixes an issue that may cause audio distortion on certain Macs
- Improves reliability when connecting to a file server using SMB2
- Fixes an issue that may cause VPN connections to disconnect
- Improves VoiceOver navigation in Mail and Finder

Besides, this update also addresses some important issues, including errors that cannot add users in iMessage. In addition, the Mail feature or the ability to make and receive calls on *FaceTime* has also been improved.

Mac OS X 10.9.2 Mavericks update can be updated automatically by going to **Menu -> Software Update** . Apple also warned that before updating, users should back up the system to avoid possible risks.
