The full update is **Mac OS X v10.6.7 Supplemental Update for 13 'MacBook Air** (Late 2010), to help solve the problem of iTunes application crashes completely.

According to information on the Apple support forum, the error started to appear after users installed the new update version of **Mac OS X 10.6.7** .

From the time of installing that version, every time a user calls the iTunes application, it will encounter hang and cannot be used.

Apple claims that the 461KB update they just released will help all customers who are using the 13-inch MacBook Air in late 2010 and run Mac OS X 10.6.7 no longer having trouble. bear on more.
