

Apple releases iOS 15.2.1 and iPadOS 15.2.1 updates, fixing a lot of important bugs

- On January 13, Apple released a new update for its iPhone and iPad devices. This iOS 15.2.1 update fixes some important bugs.

Recently, many people have encountered errors from the Messages application on iPhone. This annoys the user. To fix this situation, today (January 13, 2022) Apple has released a new update for iPhone and iPad devices. The iOS 15.2.1 update for iPhone is quite large at around 970MB, but the update notes are extremely brief. Apple says the new update fixes Messages unable to load images when users send links from iCloud.



In this update, Apple also fixed a bug that caused the third-party CarPlay app to become unresponsive. This bug seems to be serious for people who use CarPlay, because many users have reported it on technology forums before.

To fix the Messages app error on iPhone, iPad users can update to iOS 15.2.1 and iPadOS 15.2.1 according to the following instructions.

Go to Settings -> General -> Software Update. Here you choose to download and install new updates. Then you wait for the system to automatically update and restart the device.

The implementation is quite simple, but it can fix some common errors on old iOS operating system versions. If you haven't updated yet, update now.
