On March 31, Samsung and Apple will continue their persistent legal battle. The focus of this battle will be Samsung devices accused of violating five "core" technologies from Apple: Unified search, data synchronization, drag to unlock devices, touch features to dial and auto-complete (*autocomplete*).

The amount that Apple requires Samsung to compensate will be 40 USD per device ( *about 820,000 VND* ). Certainly, the Korean company will disagree with this number. In 2010, before the patent war between Apple and Samsung exploded, Apple had "solicited" Samsung to buy patent rights for \$ 30 ( *about VND 630,000* ) for each device, but the Korean company. Quoc refused this offer.

With its financial potential, Apple and Samsung will definitely not draw as **Nokia and HTC** . It seems that the conflict between **Apple and Samsung** has culminated, even though Apple will continue to use components provided by Samsung.
