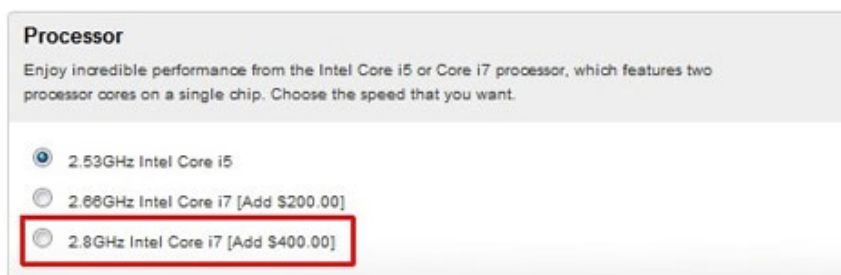


# Apple 'silently' upgrading the MacBook Pro to Core i7

Accordingly, the Macbook Pro models with 15 and 17-inch screens will have the option of Intel Core i7 processor at 2.66GHz or Core i7 speeds of 2.8 GHz with an additional cost of 200 and 400 USD. .

Versions with new options have begun for users to order and receive machines as soon as possible.

Meanwhile, the 13.3-inch Macbook Pro model has not been mentioned by Apple and still only has the option of Intel Core 2 Duo processor.
