Google Chrome's application is no longer useless as before.

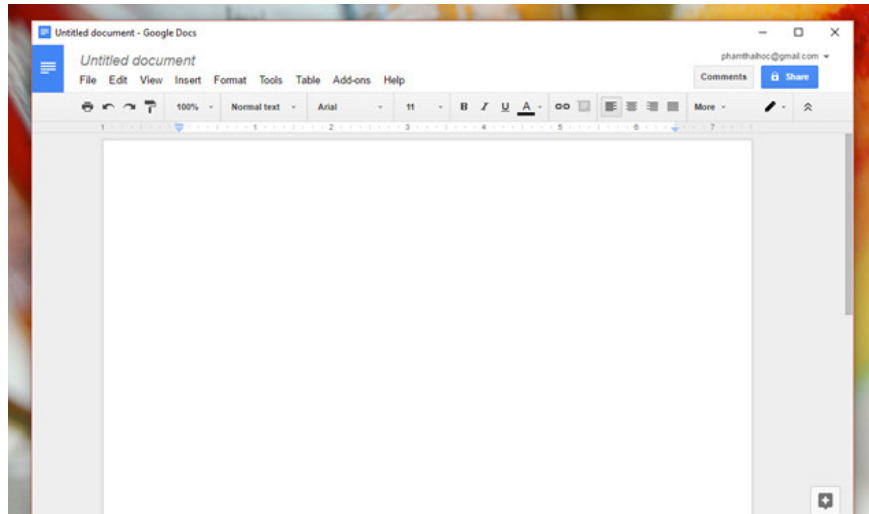
Google Chrome's application is no longer "useless" as before.

If you are too familiar with Google Chrome, it must be no stranger to these browser-based applications. However, most of these applications that require internet connection can work and appear useful.

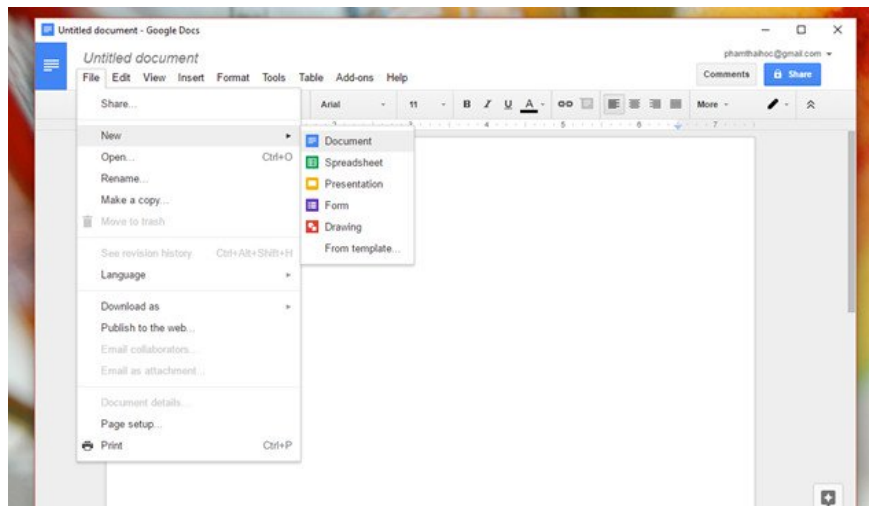


However, there are still very useful and active **Chrome** applications that do not need an internet connection, this article will suggest some of them. Please read along for reference.

Google Docs

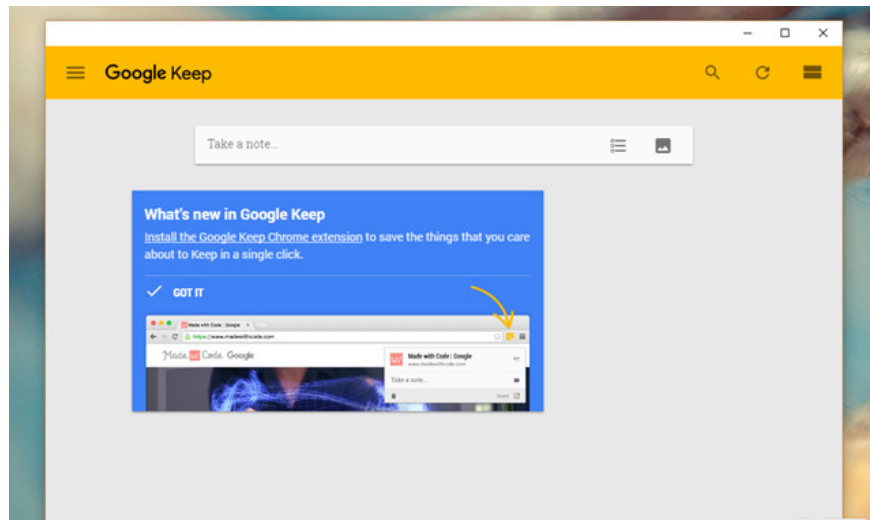

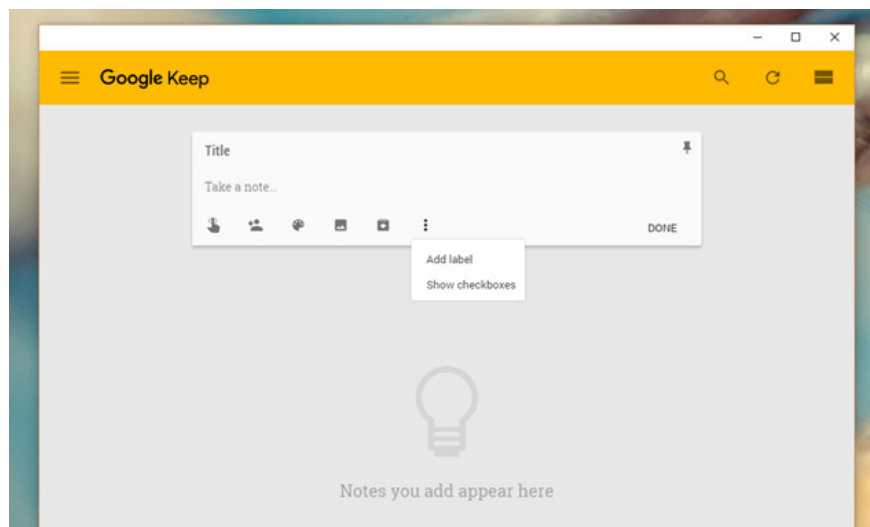


If you need to fold an Office content editor that doesn't have any Office installed, Chrome's Google Docs will be the "*lifesaver*" for you.

Google Keep

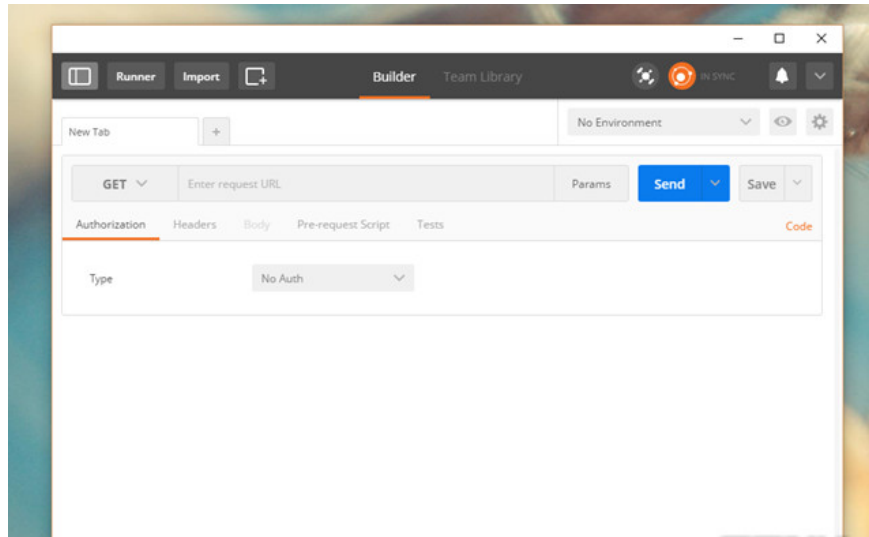

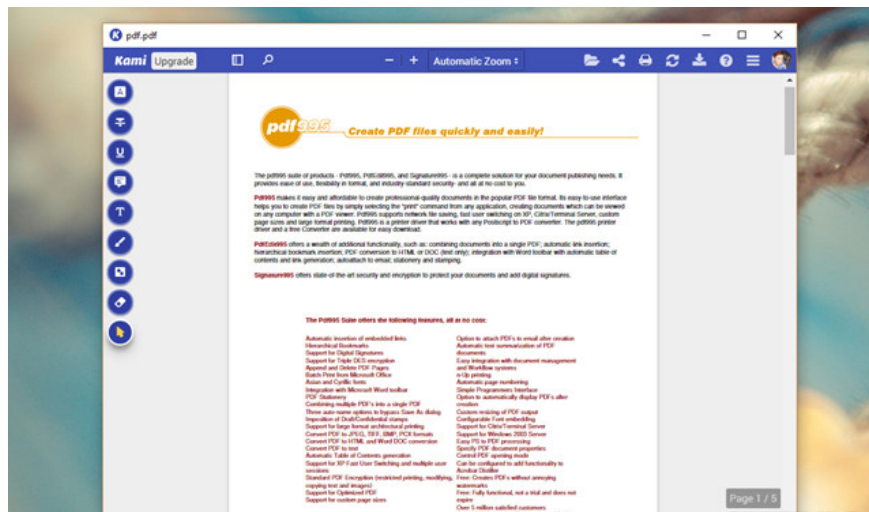
In addition, Google Keep also supports **voice memorization**, **photo notes** and many other great features.

Postman



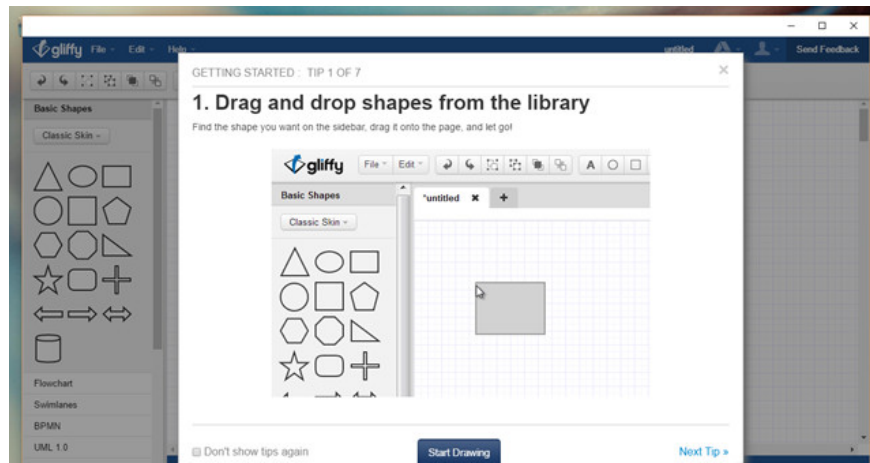

Kami



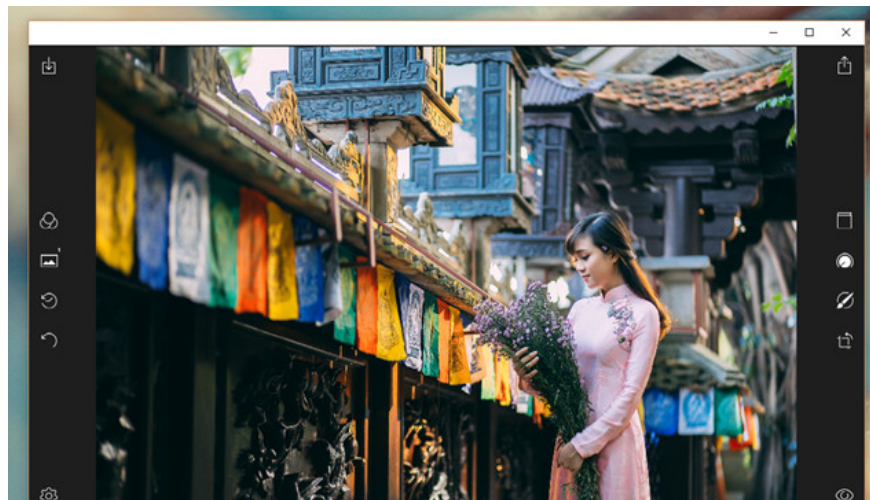

Gliffy

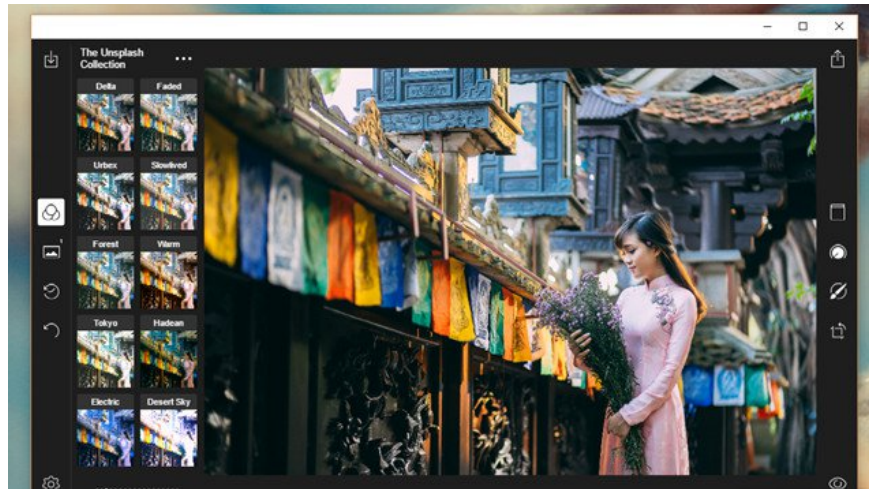

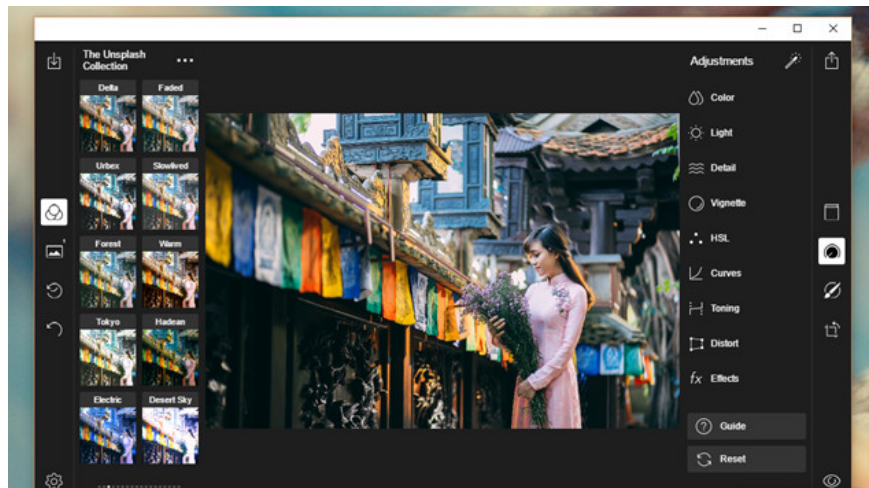
Polarr
