

Are you using your iPhone's handy lock screen widget feature?

What is a lock screen widget?

Unlike standard widgets, lock screen widgets are specifically designed to be placed on your iPhone's lock screen. They give you access to important information at a glance, helping you stay productive while minimizing additional interactions with your mobile device.

Due to limited space on the lock screen, lock screen widgets are smaller and simpler than regular widgets. However, they are still effective in serving their purpose.

What types of widgets are suitable for the lock screen?

Lock screen widgets differ from home screen widgets primarily in their scope and design. While home screen widgets are large and offer more interactive features, such as scrolling through content or performing multiple actions, lock screen widgets are smaller and support limited interactions, often limited to basic actions.

Lock screen widgets are great for displaying time-sensitive information like upcoming events or tasks, weather updates, battery information, etc. Most appear as smaller circles, and you can place up to four widgets on a single lock screen. Others may be rectangular and include more information, but also take up a bit more space. You can place two of these widgets side by side.

When choosing a lock screen widget for your iPhone, consider what important information you want to have quick access to. While individual needs and priorities may vary, there are some widgets that will be useful to most people.

1. Weather data

Checking the weather is something we all do almost every day. Having a weather widget on your lock screen will allow you to check weather updates just by glancing at your iPhone.

If you rely on another weather app like AccuWeather or the popular Carrot Weather, be sure to explore their lock screen widget options. The only caveat is that they require a premium subscription to use.

2. Tasks/notes

With lock screen widgets, you can quickly check your upcoming tasks and stay organized throughout the day. Recently, there was Structured, a visual day planner app that also comes with a few lock screen widgets. You can choose between a circle that shows your upcoming task categories and a rectangle that also shows the task title and scheduled time.

3. Health data

With many of us spending a large part of our day sitting at a desk, it's important to try to fit more physical activity into your daily routine. To stay motivated to reach your goals, track your activity from the built-in Fitness app on your lock screen. The circle option takes up less space and displays the information you need in an easy-to-read format.

4. Medicine & water

Due to health issues, many people take medication every day. To make sure you never forget to take your medication, rely on the medication lock screen widget available in the built-in Health app. Additional widgets for Mental Status or Weekly Health are also available.

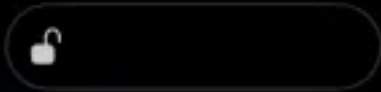

5. Battery

You can easily see your phone's battery level from the lock screen. But if you have Bluetooth accessories like a smartwatch or headphones, you can also see their battery status using the built-in Battery lock screen widget.
