

## Aspire S5 sold in the US later this month

The world's thinnest Ultrabook will be sold for \$ 1,400 for the Core i7-35i7U chip, 256GB SSD and 13.3-inch screen.

Acer has just announced it will sell the latest Aspire S5 ultrabook in the US in late June. Previously, the Taiwanese manufacturer once said it would release this product later this year.

Aspire S5 is priced from \$ 1,399. Product with the code of Aspire S5 391-9880 uses Intel Core i7-35i7U processor based on the latest Ivy Bridge platform. The supplied SSD comes with 256GB capacity. This model uses 13.3 inch screen resolution of 1366 x 768 pixels integrated camera 1.3 Megapixel HD resolution with a speed of 24 frames / sec.

In addition, Acer's new ultrabookm also integrates connections such as USB 3.0, Thunderbolt, HDMI that comes with a HDMI to VGA jack. The Aspire S5 is considered the world's thinnest ultrabook with the thinnest part being 11.17mm and the thickest being 14.98mm. The weight of this model is about 1.2kg.

The battery that came with the PowerSmart technology makes it three times longer than traditional batteries. This product can maintain standby status for 16 days and continuous use for 6.5 hours. The Aspire S5 is also equipped with technologies such as Acer Green Instant On and Always Connect to help the device start up in a

short time as well as share data anytime, anywhere, even while in *"Sleep" state*.
