

Asustek will launch the new Eee PC

Taiwanese computer company Asustek plans to launch two new low-cost notebooks Eee PC 904 and 905, likely to replace the 900 and 901 models. The Eee PC 904 and 905 have display 8.9 inch but integrated system

Taiwanese computer company Asustek plans to launch two new low-cost Eee PC 904 and 905 notebooks, possibly replacing the 900 and 901 models.

The Eee PC 904 and 905 have an 8.9-inch display screen but integrate the same-size key system with the keyboard for its 10.2-inch models. This is the fundamental difference between these two models and the previous models of Asustek's Eee PC.



The Eee PC 904 and 905 will still use low-cost Intel Atom processors and Asustek is also evaluating the possibility of making a difference in storage capacity and battery life of the two new models. this.

Asustek expects that the Eee PC 904 and 905 will cost the equivalent of two 900 and 901 models and the future may replace those two models in the market.

Asustek is also considering a discount for two models 900 and 901 so that it can be fully "closed" in stock or continue to maintain them in the market to compete against the affordable compact Acer Aspire computer. One.
