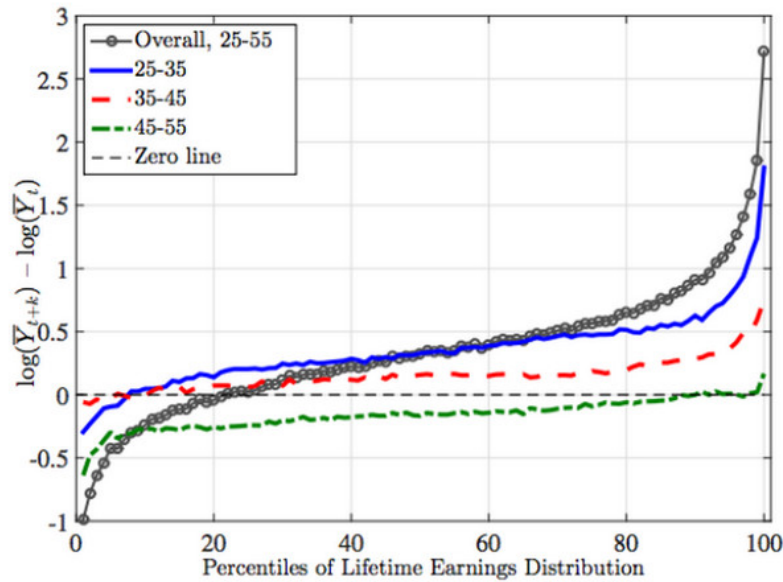

Again, the chart shows that the high growth in income occurred in the first 10 years when we started working (the blue line).
