

Auto Click and how to automatically click when playing games

AutoClick also has a mode that allows you to record multiple locations to click and automatically perform them. Right now we will go to learn about how to use Autoclick - Auto click software to play this game.

If you are feeling uncomfortable having to repeat the mouse click repeatedly during the game, let the Auto Click tool help you replace this boring job automatically. This is an extremely useful tool used by many gamers today, it allows you to set the interval between each click, select a single click or double click mode, and can activate the keys Other functions. AutoClick also has a mode that allows you to record multiple locations to click and automatically perform them. Right now we will go to learn about how to use Autoclick - Auto clicker software to play this game.

How to use AutoClick to automatically click when playing games

Note: Auto click has many different versions like Auto click 2.2, 2.5, 3.1.2, in this tutorial we will go together to learn how to use GS Auto Clicker to play auto games.

First, you need to download and install the software automatically click on the computer is Auto Click under the link below.

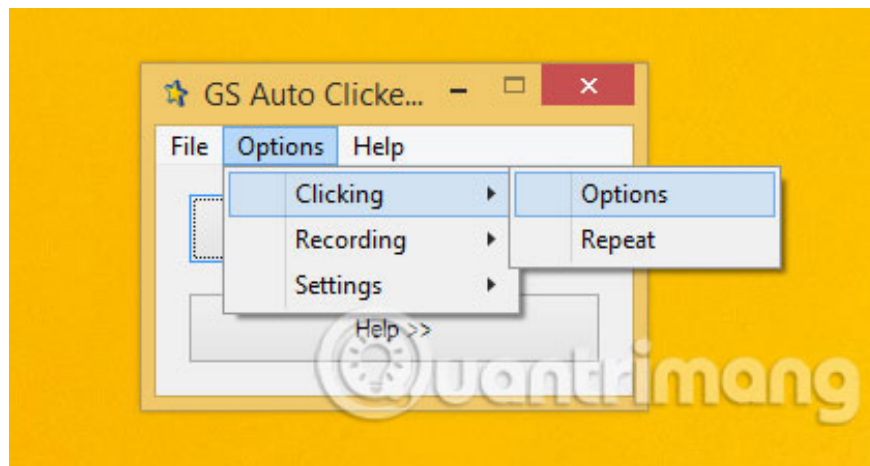

After the installation is successful, launch the Auto Click software. Right at the GS Auto Clicker interface, you will see a very simple symbol "Press F8 to click", press the F8 key to start the automatic mouse click (by default, automatically left click), continue to press F8 to finish.



In the main interface GS Auto Clicker will have 3 options, but important and mainly used are **Options** . Here, there are many features that you need to know:

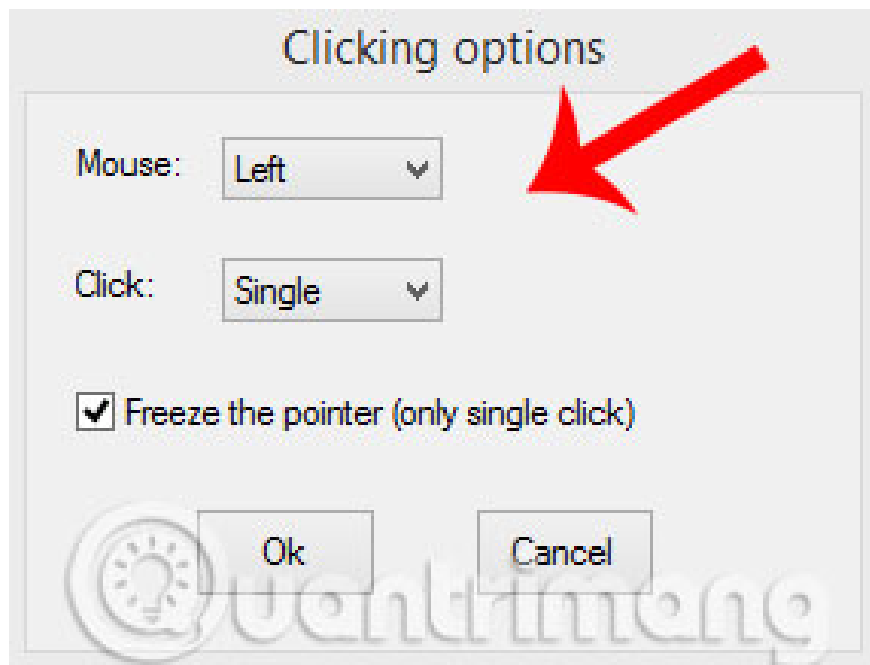
1. **Clicking** : Option to click.
2. **Recording** : Optional location, number of mouse clicks.
3. **Settings** : Other settings.



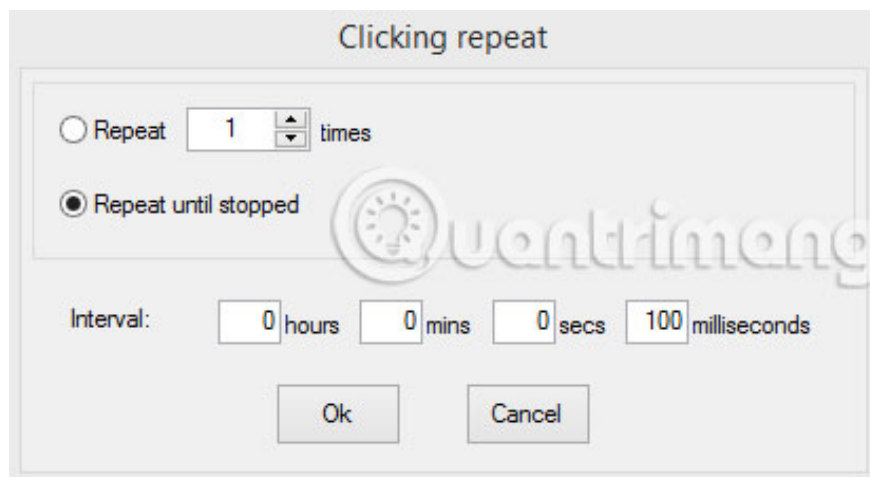
1. Clicking

The Options> Clicking section has 2 small options, **Options** and **Repeat** . With Options, you have the option of clicking the mouse (selecting the mouse). Specifically, the **Mouse** section allows you to change the mouse click Left (Left), Right (right) and Middle (middle). **Click** to select either Single (Single) or Double (double click).

In addition, the **Freeze** option of **the pointer** allows you to freeze the mouse when performing automatic click, but only applies to single click.

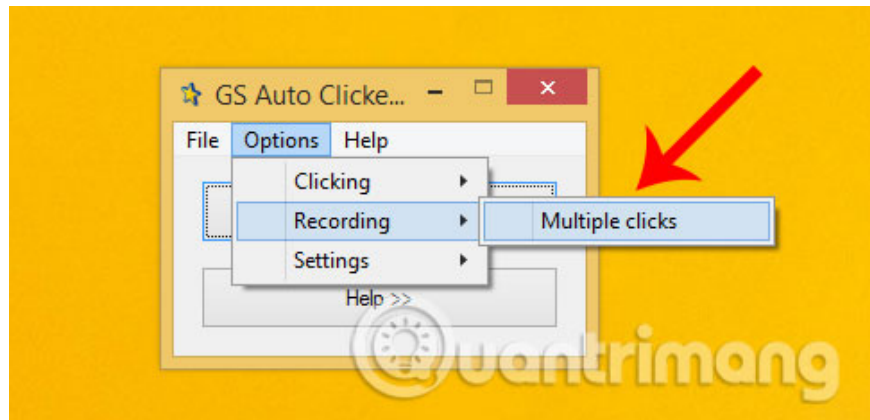


With Repeat, you can set how you click, click several times, each time, through your options. Check the **Repeat** option and set the Click or **Repeat until stopped number** to set up the click until you request a stop. Besides, the **Interval** section below also helps you do more, this is the setting action to adjust the click speed (the distance between each click) how long to click once.

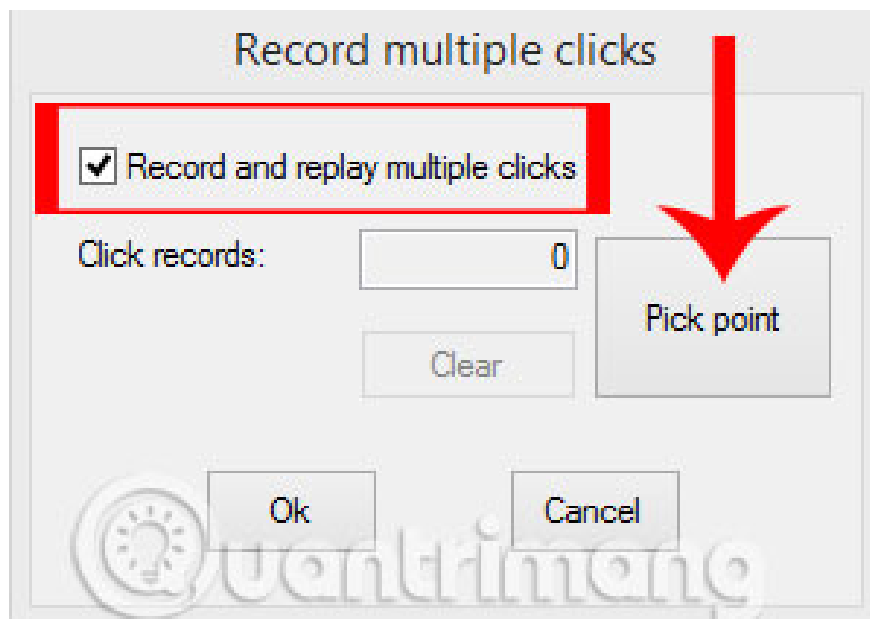


2. Recording

The next part is Recording, in this section there is only one option, **Multiple Clicks**, but it is also a very important feature, allowing you to record mouse click operation and repeat the same way.



Open the Record multiple clicks dialog box, check the **Record and replay multiple clicks box**, then click on **Pick point** and click any point on the screen to let the software record the location automatically, repeat the same operation. for other coordinates to record. **Click records** will display all the points you have selected. Once set, press **Ok** to save the changes.



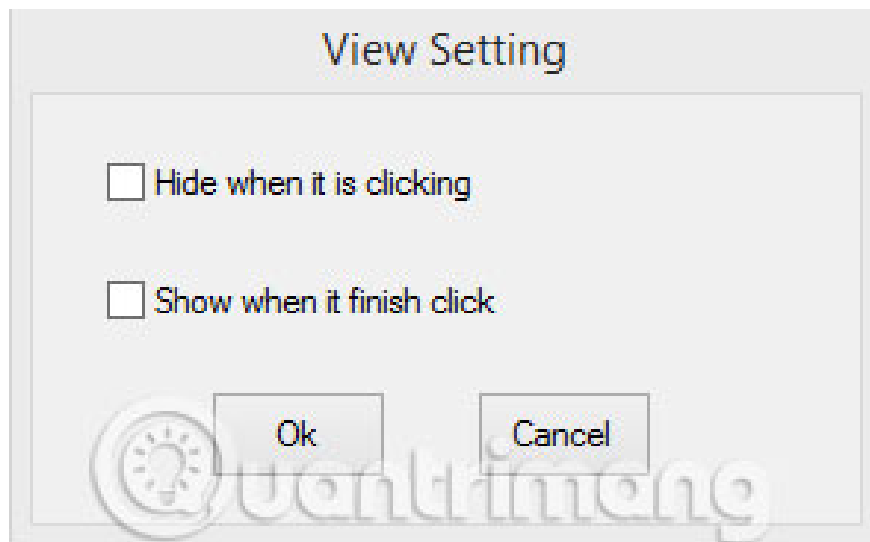
3. Settings

Finally, Settings with 3 main parts is the **HotKey** (change shortcut), **View** (display mode) and **Other** (other options).

With Hotkey, if you feel that the shortcut starts / stops F8 coincides with another shortcut, you can change the Hotkey shortcut as you like by clicking the **Click / Stop** box and pressing the hotkey to set up later. Click **OK** to finish.



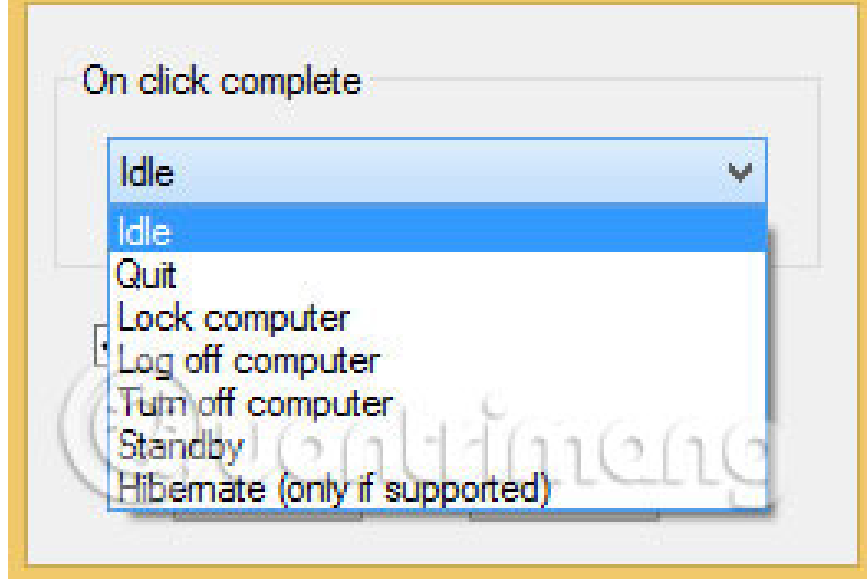
Selecting View allows you to set up two functions as **Hide when it is clicking** - Hiding the window when performing automatic clicking. Or **Show when it finish click** - Display the window when you stop clicking or completing the click.



Other feature is where you can set up your computer with the corresponding commands such as:

1. **Idle** - Standby mode.
2. **Quit** - Automatically exit the program.
3. **Lock computer** - Lock the computer again.
4. **Log off computer** - Sign out.
5. **Turn off computer** - **Turn off** the computer.
6. **Standby** - Leave the computer on sleep mode.
7. **Hibernate** - **Active** sleep mode (if supported).

Other setting



Set up to use Auto Clicker, go back to the main menu of the tool and press the hotkey that has been set up to start the auto-click experience. With the speed of Auto Click as well as the convenience of this tool, you will definitely save a lot of time and avoid mouse wear when there is an auto click tool to help you do that. Hopefully, the manual for GS Auto Clicker or the basic way of using Auto Click gives you the most useful information to use the software in the most optimal way.
