

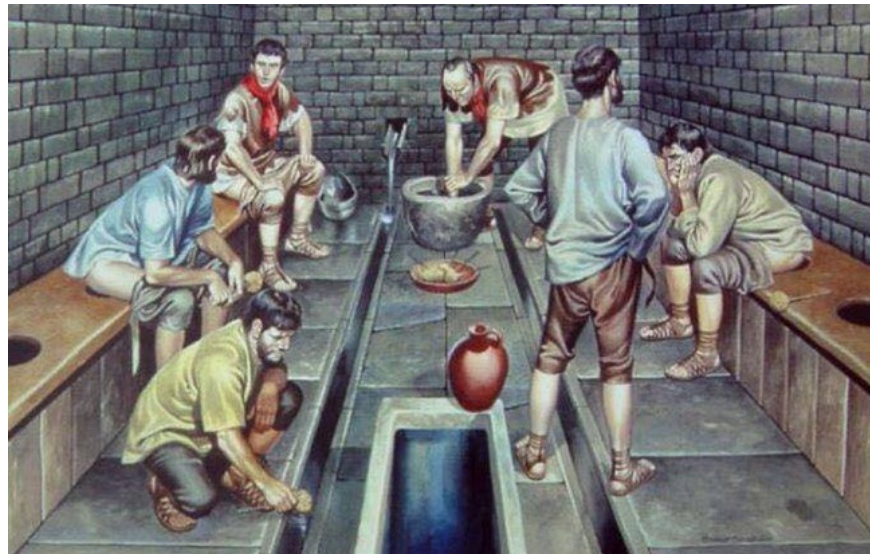
# Back in the past to find out how the ancient Romans went to the toilet

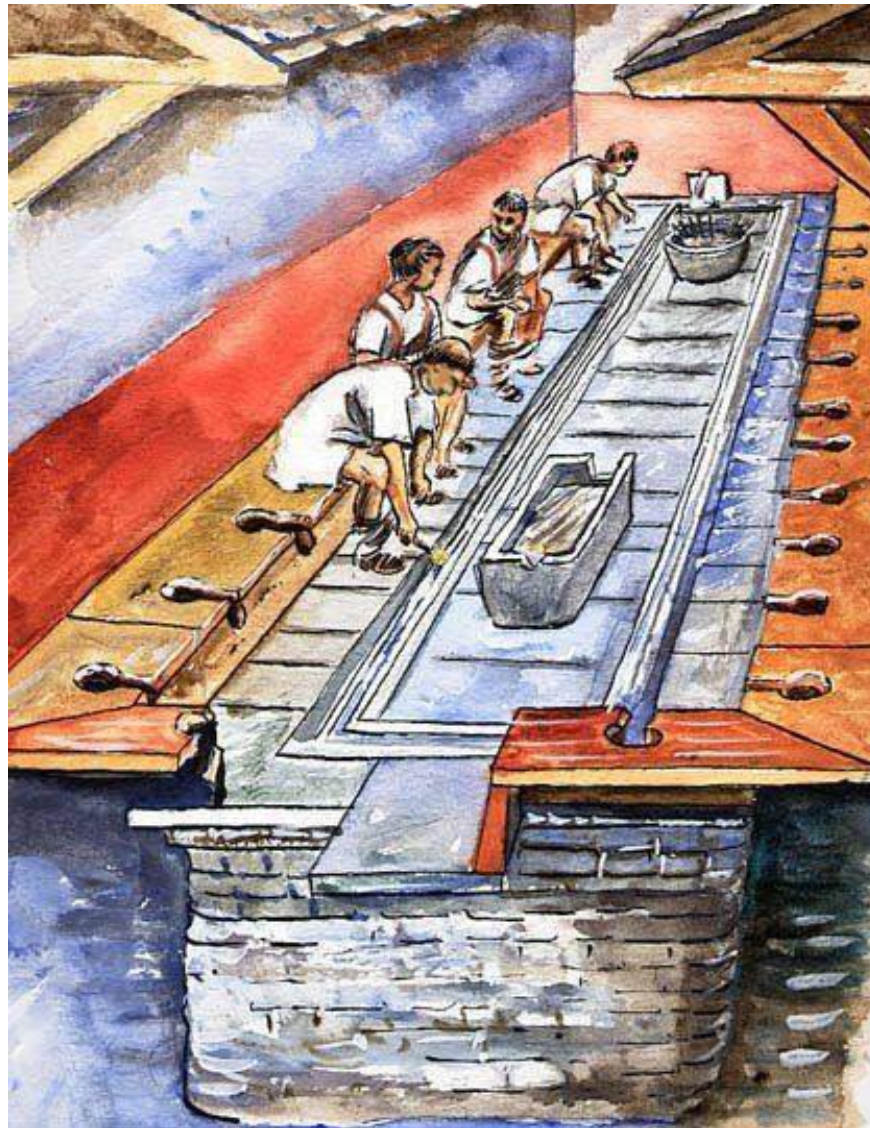
In order to keep the city environment clean, not flooded with garbage and the stench, the ancient Romans devised a system of public toilets, public baths .

The system of public toilets of the ancient Romans was very simple, consisting only of rocks or wood carved with small holes, connected to each other, without a lid.
