

Backup and restore Bookmark on Google Chrome

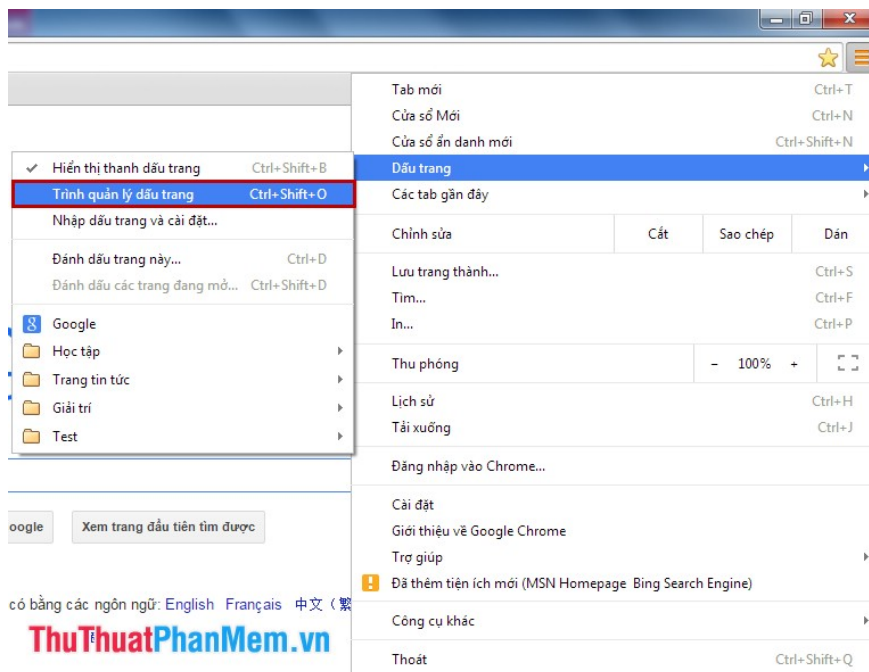
Instructions to backup and restore bookmarks on Chrome.

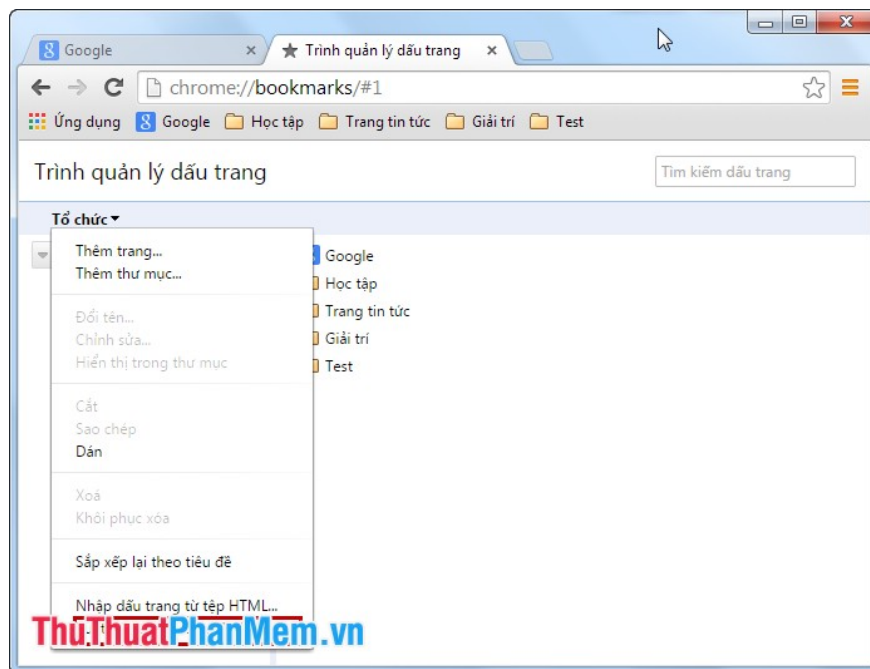
You can perform the following simple steps:

Back up Bookmarks

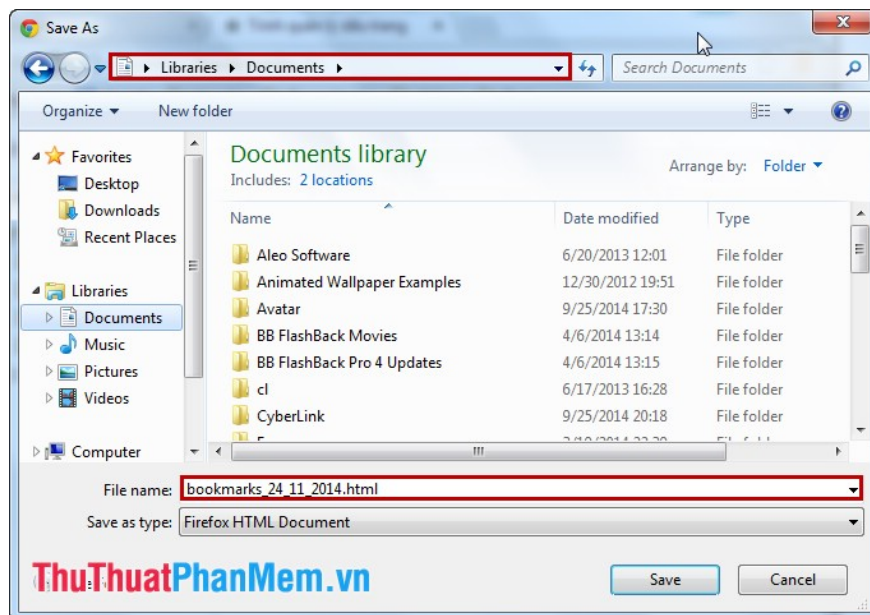
Step 1: First you select the icon **Customize and control** , choose **Bookmarks** then select **Manager bookmarks** or you press the key combination **Ctrl + Shift + O** .



Step 2: On the Bookmark **Manager** tab , select **Organize and** then select **Export bookmarks to HTML file** .

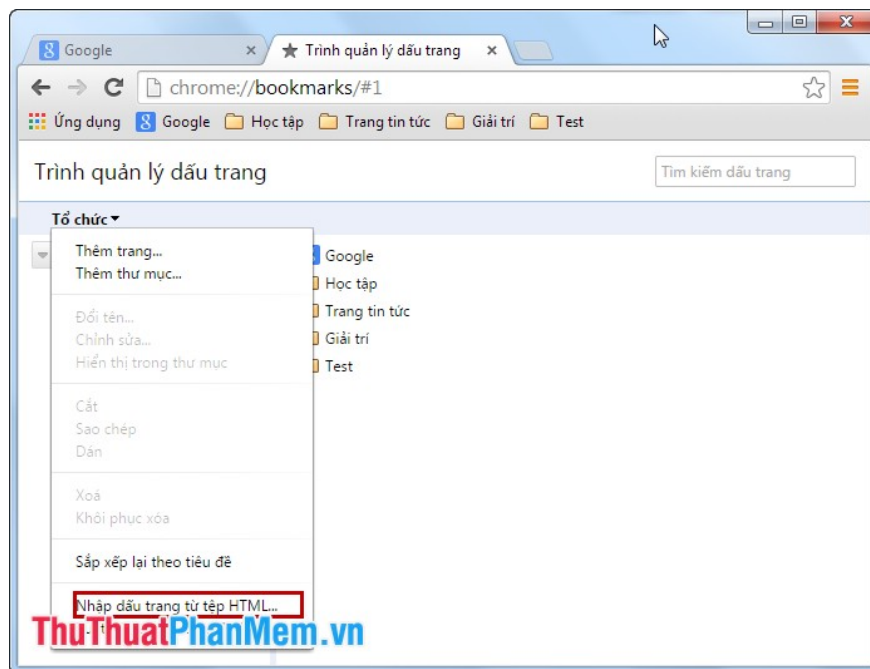


Step 3: Enter the file name and choose the location to save the backup file, then select **Save** .

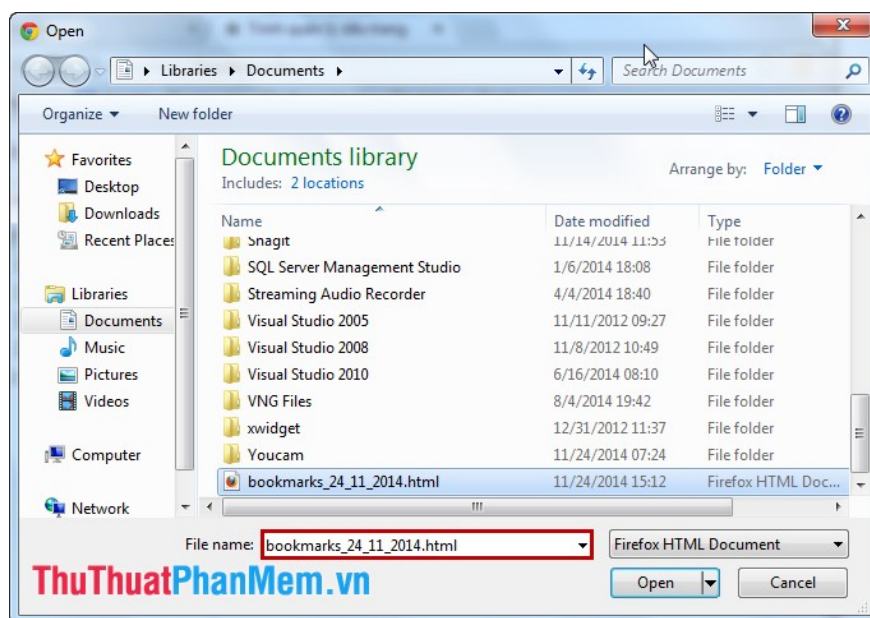


Restore Bookmark

Also in the Bookmark **Manager** tab, select **Organize and** then select **Import bookmarks from HTML file** .



Next, select the backup file ending in *.html* and click **Open** .



So the bookmark has been restored.
