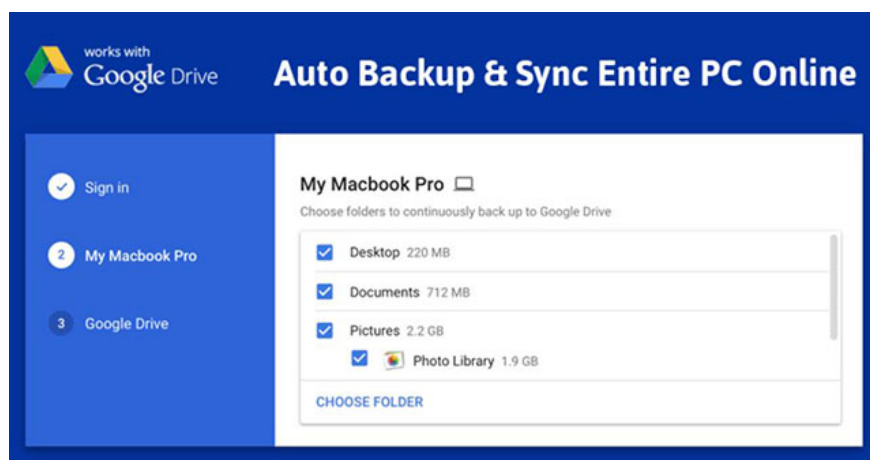


Backup and sync your entire PC to the cloud with Google's new tool
