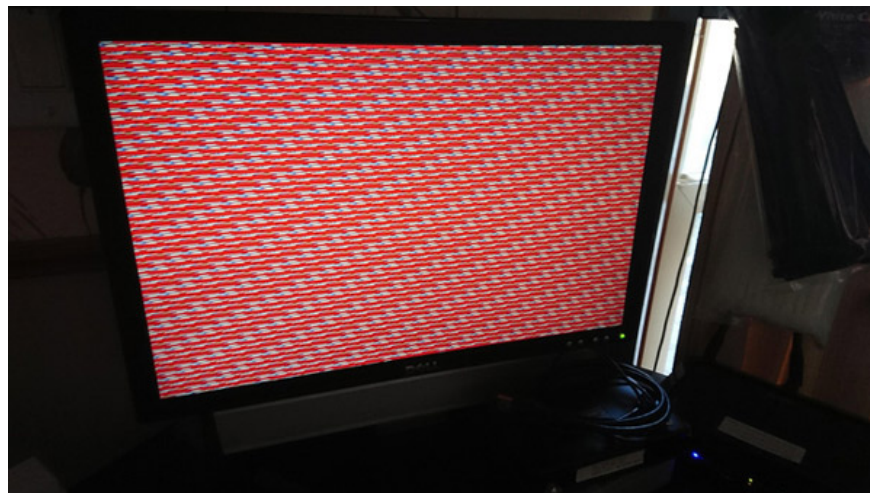
Someone had accidentally pulled a string from this pile, causing the entire office to lose their lives. Looking at this pile, the repairman felt confused.



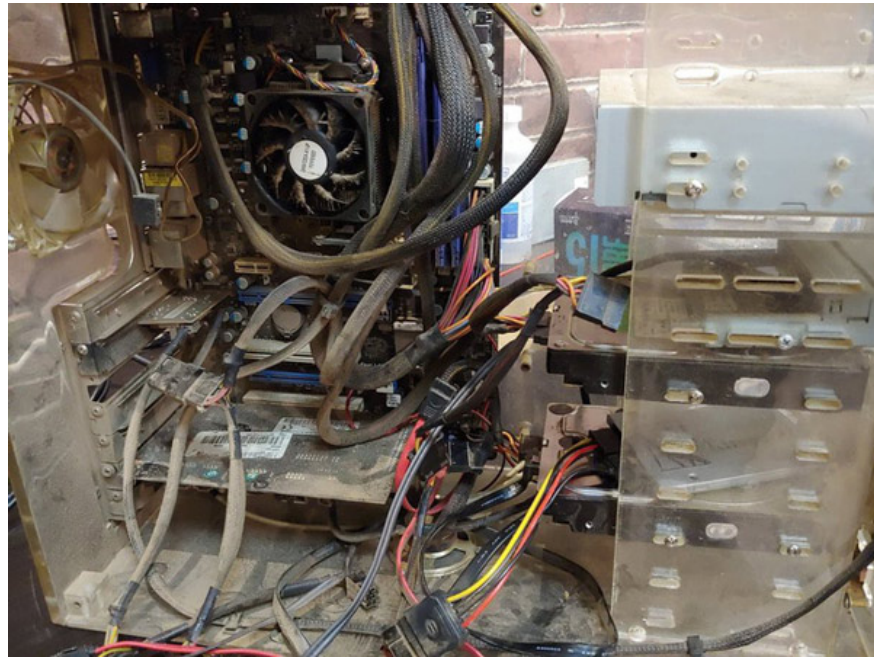
When he was called to fix the problem, the repairman wondered if he should only fix the blue screen error or promote a fixed screw-up service.

Looking at this scene, the repairman could only complain "What is this? How the hell did they let it be like that .?"



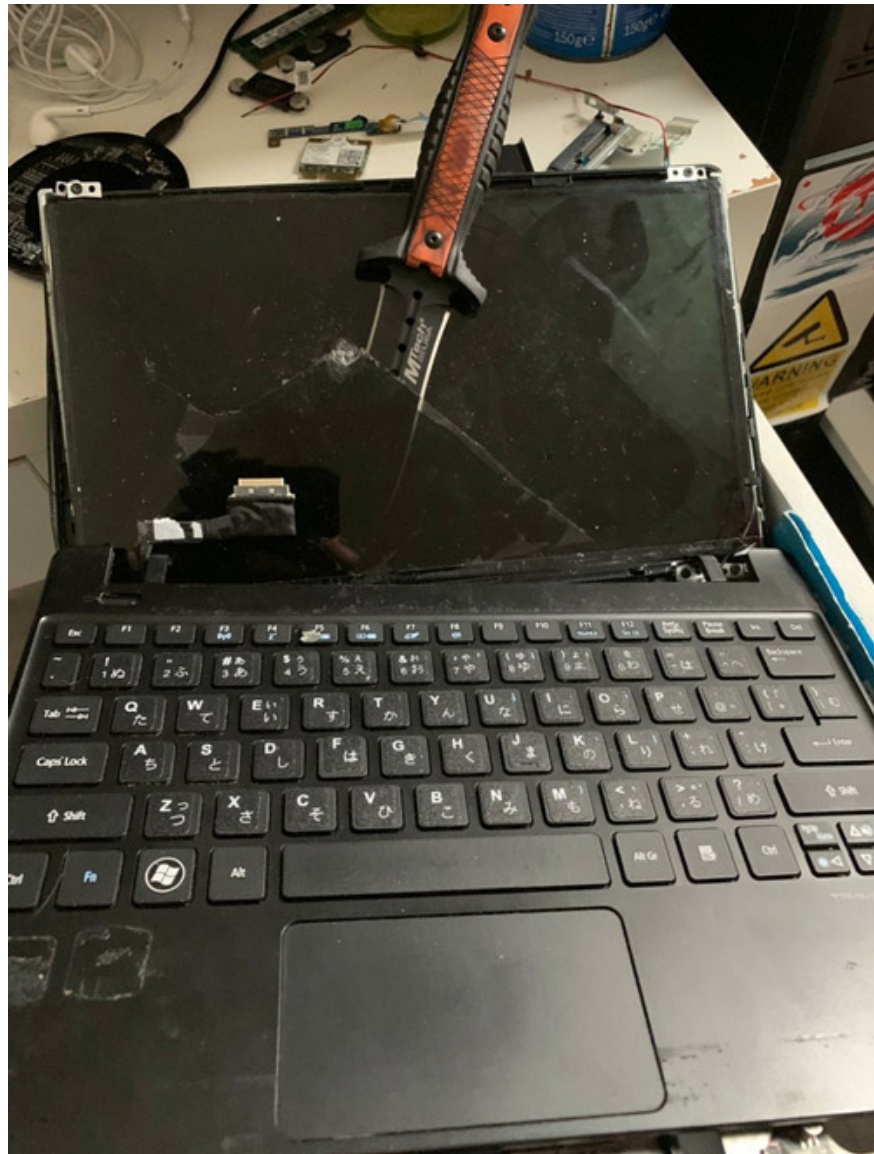
Called to fix this, the computer repairman was puzzled about when he switched to being a PR support ad specialist.



Great creativity, but the use of glue to connect the power cord and the computer is always bundled.



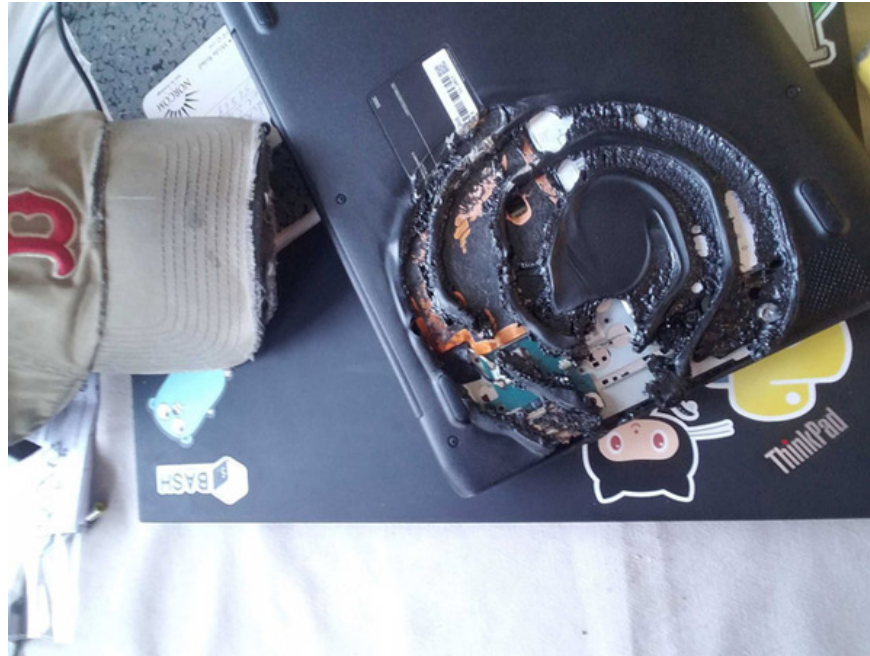
Probably the mechanic repairman is also "out of the mind" when meeting this 1-0-2 error.
