

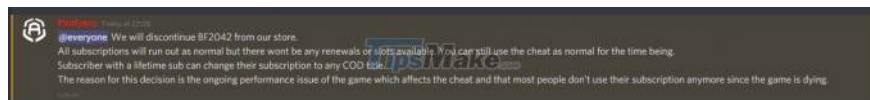
Battlefield 2042 has so many bugs that even hackers have to stop playing
