

# Beeping, stopping flowers blooming right on Tet

Some experiences to promote or stop flowers bloom right on Tet, help your family always have fresh, beautiful and long-lasting flowers to play in Tet days.

Weather (warm or cold sunshine) can cause your family's branches / pots / pots to bloom before or after Tet. If your flowers are having one of these two signs, you can use some of the following experiences to promote or stop the flowering of the right Tet, helping your family always have beautiful, long, beautiful flowers. Decay to play in Tet days.

## 1. Block flowers if flowers bloom early

### With peach blossom

If your peach branch grows 3-4 days before Tet, only 1/2 of the branches are left on the branch. To slow down the blooming flowers by 3-5 days, the flowers are always beautiful, you can do the following:

1. Step 1: Remove clean rice husks or sawdust into a thick, transparent plastic bag.
2. Step 2: Pour water around.
3. Step 3: Plug the peach branch into the bag and then tie the bag tightly.
4. Step 4: Plug the peach branches and keep the bag in the bottle.



Note:

1. This method only applies to peach branches without burning stumps.
2. Place peach branches in sheltered places, without changing water.

3. Rice husk bag and water in the bag can be used for about 1 week. Water can be added to warm enough if it is dry.

**With other flowers.**

1. Keep pots / flower pots in a darker place, avoiding the sun. This applies to all kinds of chrysanthemum, apricot, poinsettia.
2. Limiting the temperature helps the flowers to slow down.  
Flowers such as carnations, hibiscus, sunflower, rhododendron . apply this way. Not applicable to gladiolus flowers.



1. Place flowers in a dry environment (using a dehumidifier, air conditioner) to inhibit the growth of flowers.
2. Pruning, peeling, picking buds to prevent nutrients from moving from leaves to roots helps control the growth of flowers in the tree.
3. Limit watering, just water enough to moisten the plants depending on the weather.

With gladiolus flowers, daisies, dahlia blooming early, you can practice in the following way so that the flowers are still beautiful, 3-5 more days fresh.

1. Put some cotton soaked in small plastic bags, pour water just enough moisture. Then plug each flower into a plastic bag, fasten the mouth of the bag, put it into a jar for a cool, airtight place.
2. In addition, you can also put a few drops of purple medicine in the water to flower to kill bacteria to help the flowers slow down.



## **2. End flower**

### **With peach blossom**

Flowers peaches bloom late due to cold weather, you can promote early blooming flowers 1-2 days. The light stalk of the original dig through the fire, (not to scorch) and immediately plug it into the bottle full of water. Change water daily. If the flower bud still does not bloom, drop the peach branches into the water at night, put flowers into the jar during the day and spray water on the branches.

### **With all kinds of gladiolus flowers, daisies, dahlia**

For flowers to bloom 2-3 days earlier, you can do it in one of two ways:

1. Put flowers in warm water 35-40 degrees, change water twice a day and spray lightly on leaves and flowers. At night, place a vase of flowers in a warm, windy launch.
2. Drop some aspirin into the flower arrangement to provide more nutrition, mineral salts, help the growth process increase, promote flower bloom soon.
