

Best HDMI cable for monitors, LG TVs, Samsung and Apple TVs

Looking for the best HDMI cable for LG, Samsung, Apple TV TVs? The following HDMI cables promise to deliver durable quality for all types of media.

Color-coded RCA cables are long gone. Thankfully we have the technology to replace three different connectors with just one cable. Newer TVs and 4K monitors support HDMI cables, instead of RCA. For modern Blu-ray disc players and game consoles, you cannot play games or play discs without an HDMI cable.

How to choose an HDMI cable

Spending a lot of money on HDMI cables does not improve the sound quality and TV picture. The \$ 10 cable is as good as the \$ 30 cable. Do not let the price convince you that cable better. If you find a more expensive HDMI cable, it's probably due to its length.

Generally speaking, there are 4 main types of HDMI cables for monitors and TVs:

1. Standard
2. Standard with ethernet
3. High speed
4. High speed with ethernet

While you don't need to care about HDMI cables, it's good to know them. Today, most HDMI cables are of high speed and are equipped with ethernet capability.

If you have an 8K TV, you will benefit from the latest HDMI cable: HDMI 2.1. This cable can transmit videos up to 10K to the screen. Although most TVs do not yet support 8K resolution, you can expect this in the future.

Need an HDMI splitter or HDMI switch?

Although you don't necessarily need a splitter and HDMI switch, both are useful in some situations.

The HDMI splitter is used when you want to display the same media from a game console or Blu-ray disc player on multiple TVs. You just need to plug the device's HDMI cable into the HDMI splitter. Because the splitter has several HDMI outputs, it is possible to plug them into multiple TVs to display content simultaneously on those TVs.

On the other hand, HDMI switch helps to organize the cable more neatly. They are especially useful if you only have or two HDMI ports on the TV. To use the HDMI switch, just plug all the HDMI cables into the switch.

You can then plug the switch cable into the HDMI port of the TV. This way you won't have to switch between different HDMI cables. The switch allows switching between multiple HDMI displays while using only one HDMI port.

1. SecurOMax 4K HDMI 2.0 Cable (139 thousand VND)



SecurOMax 4K 2.0 cable is a cheap option especially when durable cables are needed. It is 15 feet long (~4.6m), comfortable to connect to consoles or Blu-ray players to TVs.

This HDMI cable with ethernet supports 4K resolution. It also comes with a gold-plated braided wire and connector for the highest performance.

2. Cable Matters 3-Pack HDMI 2.0 Cable Matters (313 thousand VND)



If you have a lot of TVs, Cable Matters 3-Pack HDMI 2.0 is the HDMI cable you need. This cable comes with three 6-pin cables so you can use different devices on three separate TVs.

Each cable allows bandwidth up to 18Gbps and supports 4K resolution. These cables are also color coded. So it's convenient to use all three HDMI cables for a TV, so you can easily know which device belongs to which device.

3. AmazonBasics 4K HDMI 2.0 Cable (VND 162,000)



Want an HDMI cable for less than VND 200,000? You can choose an AmazonBasics 4K HDMI 2.0 cable. This cable is also available in sizes ranging from 3 to 25 feet (~ 1m to 7.6m) at a reasonable price. 3-pin cable is the cheapest but its quality doesn't fluctuate much compared to the longer options.

Nylon braided cable is perfect for connecting any 4K device to your TV. Like most other cables on this list, it also supports 18Gbps bandwidth.

4. PowerBear 4K HDMI 2.0 Cable (278 thousand VND)



PowerBear 4K HDMI 2.0 cable is famous for durability. It can handle 4K resolution as well as bandwidth up to 18Gbs. This cable comes with double braided nylon sheath and gold-plated connector making it even more reliable.

PowerBear claims the 15 feet cable can withstand more than 6 thousand crimps. If you're not happy with the cable, you can rest assured it comes with a lifetime warranty.

5. Atevon 4K HDMI 2.0 cable (278 thousand VND)



The Atevon 4K HDMI 2.0 cable is a great option for receiving clear video and crisp audio delivered straight to the TV or monitor. You can expect ethernet capability, bandwidth up to 18Gbs, and compatibility with 4K TVs from this HDMI cable.

Atevon claims this cable will be able to withstand 10,000 bends. It is made with nylon braided casing and has 24K gold-plated connectors.

6. SecurOMax 8K 6-pin HDMI 2.1 cable (395 VND)



This is the only cable that supports 8K TVs on this list. You do not have to pay extra for HDMI 2.1 cable when there is no TV that supports 8K resolution. Using HDMI 2.1 cable with 4K TV, you will see no difference in quality.

SecurOMax 8K 6-Foot HDMI 2.1 cable is fully compatible with 8K TVs and allows 48Gbs bandwidth. It is thin and flexible, making it easy to fit into tight spaces. In addition, this HDMI cable comes with a gold-plated connection as well as a braided cord.

You do not need to think much about buying an HDMI cable. Before buying a cable, just make sure it is the right length and confirm whether an HDMI 2.0 or HDMI 2.1 cable is needed. If not, you may end up paying too much. It is best to simply choose an HDMI cable.
