

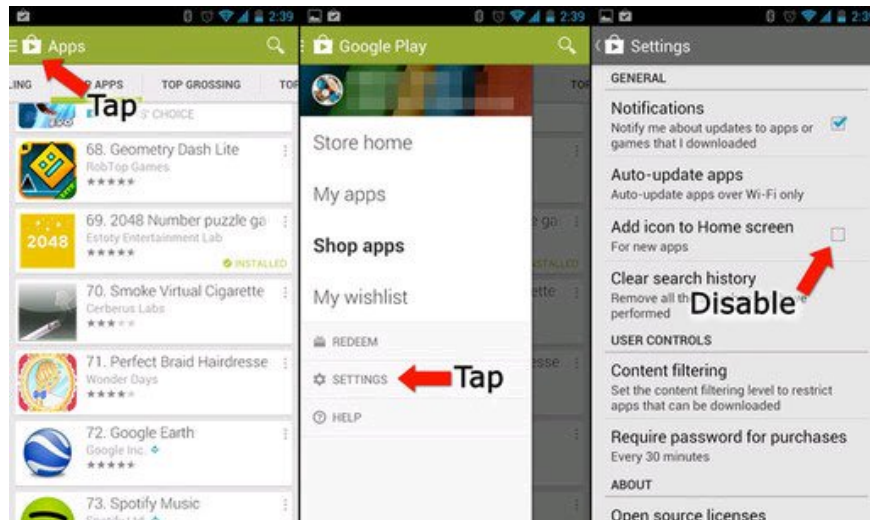
Block Android apps automatically create shortcuts automatically on the main screen

First, we visit the Google Play Store store, then select **the icon 3 dash** , another interface appears, select **Settings** . In the **Settings** section, we uncheck " **Add icon to Home screen for new apps** " (*Add icon to the Home screen*). Thus, later applications will not be able to automatically install shortcuts to the main screen anymore.
