1. Go to the **Privacy Settings** section and click **Customize Settings** .
2. Scroll down to the " **Suggest Photos of Me to Friends** " settings section and select " **Edit Settings** " .
3. In the drop-down window on the right, click " **Disable** " .

That's what you need. From now on, your friends will have to automatically tag you instead of Facebook automatically suggesting they do this.
