While Boost Mobile was previously owned by Sprint for a while before being acquired by T-Mobile in 2020 and sold to Dish to maintain (the image of) US cellular market competition, the prepaid provider is becoming increasingly difficult to surpass in terms of value for money.

Following the release of numerous intriguing "carrier-crushing" plans in recent months that came with a few too many restrictions or overly complicated special conditions, Boost has made remarkably little fuss around what may be its best and most straightforward choice to date.

Get This Incredible New Unlimited Deal Right Here

This is only accessible to new users, and it costs \$25 per month. As long as you sign up for the carrier's Autopay program, the price won't change. That's essentially a one-two blow delivered to Verizon and AT&T, who both overcharge customers for unlimited service and raise pricing without much consideration for factors like loyalty.

Although there is always a "catch," your \$25 a month will provide you access to Boost Mobile's "extended data network" (which includes T-Mobile in addition to AT&T) and even (limited) 5G availability.

The "unlimited" mobile data included in this ridiculously inexpensive new plan "may" slow down once you consume 30GB, but your unlimited phone calls and text messages will obviously have no restrictions at all. The \$50 plan delivered 35 gigabytes of "high speed" monthly data; nevertheless, given the 50% savings, we can surely conclude that the sacrifice was well worth it.

The only other thing to keep in mind is that the \$25 monthly plan doesn't include a separate mobile hotspot allowance. Tethering is therefore permitted, but its use will be added to the 30 GB high-speed bucket indicated before.

However, according to Boost Mobile, this is currently the "lowest priced unlimited plan in the US," outpacing Metro by T-entry-level Mobile's choice, for example, by a whopping \$15.

Meanwhile, given the enormous price difference and the radically different target groups, it is obviously not worthwhile to compare what Boost is providing here with Verizon, AT&T, or T-unlimited Mo's postpaid plans.

Methodology

I noted the main factors I would be looking into before I started testing phone plans. I would be able to compare phone plans accurately and get a complete picture of what to anticipate from the service in this way. I tried each phone plan out, paying close attention to the following main points:

1. The duration. In order to assess the network's dependability and get customer feedback, I tried each phone plan for 30 days.
2. Signing up To record the process of getting started, checking phone compatibility or BYOD (bring your own device), how long it takes to receive the SIM card, and the activation process, I signed up for each phone plan myself.
3. Reliability. I observed how frequently the tested phone plan had service using my personal AT&T line as a reference point and made note of any dropped calls or undeliverable text messages.
4. Service. I placed/received at least 15 calls and at least 15 texts throughout the month. Using speedtest.net, I also evaluated the phone's data and hotspot speeds.
5. Customer service. I used all accessible methods to get in touch with customer service while I was checking out each phone service to see which was the most effective, how long it took to get through, and how beneficial the experience was.
