He witnessed it all: war, famine, pain, recovery, and rebirth. Then at the age of 101, destiny set for him a new challenge - an enemy both silent and extremely cruel. "*

The doctors in Rimini have dedicated themselves to the treatment of this particular patient. *"With the heartbreaking truth that the virus is the most dangerous for the elderly, we all hope for a fairy tale for the centenarian man."*

*"In the end, Mr. P has done it! The family welcomed him home yesterday afternoon. He gave us a lesson, that the future still lies ahead even though you are 101 years old" - deputy the mayor was touched.*

It is known that Mr. P was born in 1919, right in the middle of the Spanish flu pandemic. This is the most terrible disaster in history, claiming the lives of about 30-50 million people worldwide.

101 years later, the world faces the Covid-19 pandemic again. To date, it has swept through 197 countries and territories, leaving more than 549,000 people infected and more than 24,800 dead.

The current epidemic is Italy with 80,589 cases and 8,215 deaths (the highest number of deaths in the world). Rimini city - home of the 101-year-old man - also has 1,189 people infected.
