

Build DTCL Void squad season 9

Void DTCL season 9 will summon an egg, this egg can hatch into different support characters including the Rift Herald and especially Baron Nashor.

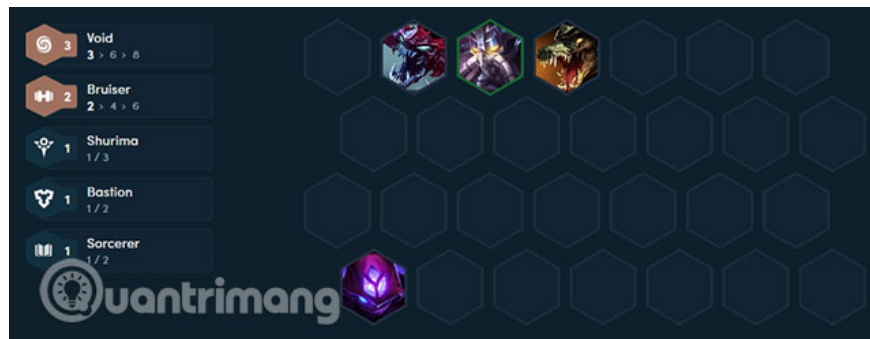
Void will therefore be in the top strongest **DTCL lineups** most often even if the meta game changes later.

If you are planning to use Void to climb rank or more, you can take a look at some suggestions below.

Build the Void DTCL season 9 squad

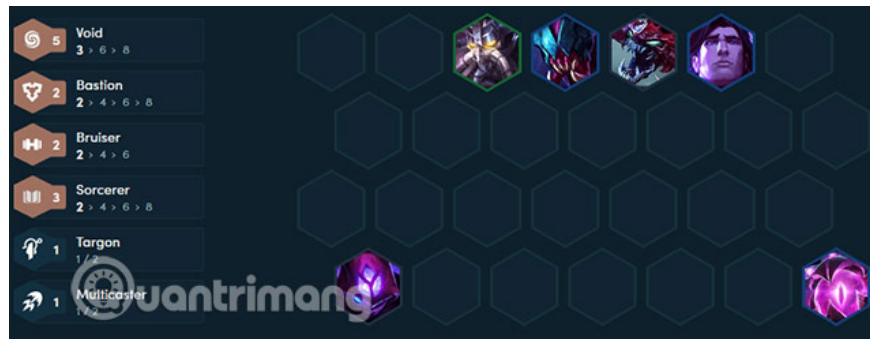
Early game

Start with 3 Void and a 4th champion, depending on when you need to take resistance or damage, add a 4th champion according to your needs. At this point, you only need to increase stars for the Void generals and don't need to pay too much attention to the remaining generals. Get to level 4 within 2-1.



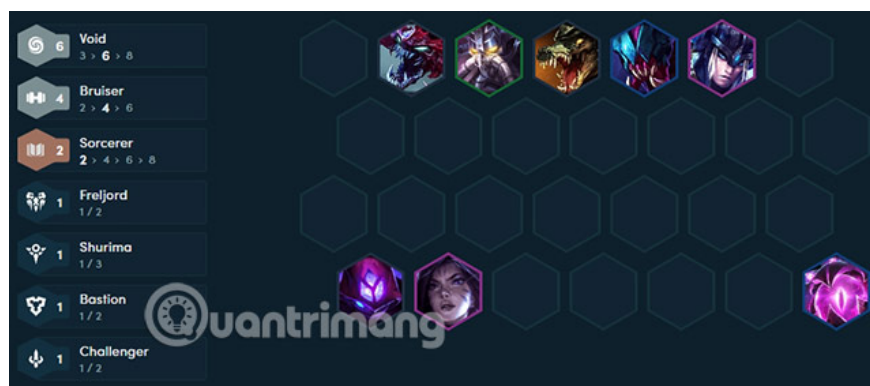
Between game

Continue playing 5 Void and add Taric to increase clan buffs in the team. If you're lucky and see Kai'Sa when you reach level 7, you'll have the Rift Herald.

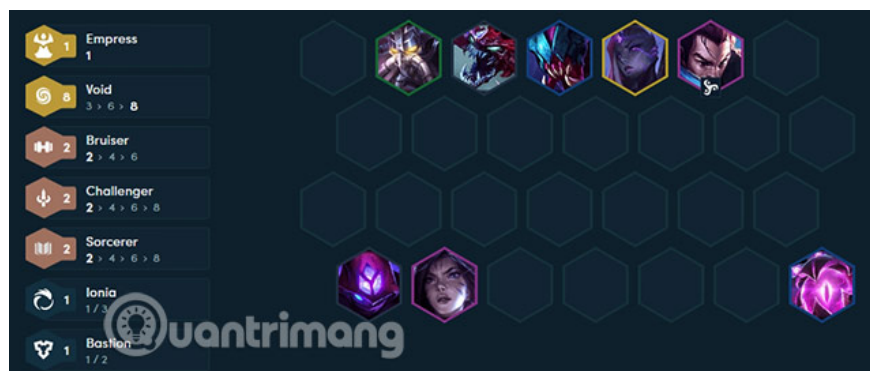


End of game

You can complete this Season 9 TFT Void team with only 6 Voids and add Fighters. So you can balance both damage and resistance. Rek'Sai is a card that is both a tank and can deal good damage in the middle of the game.

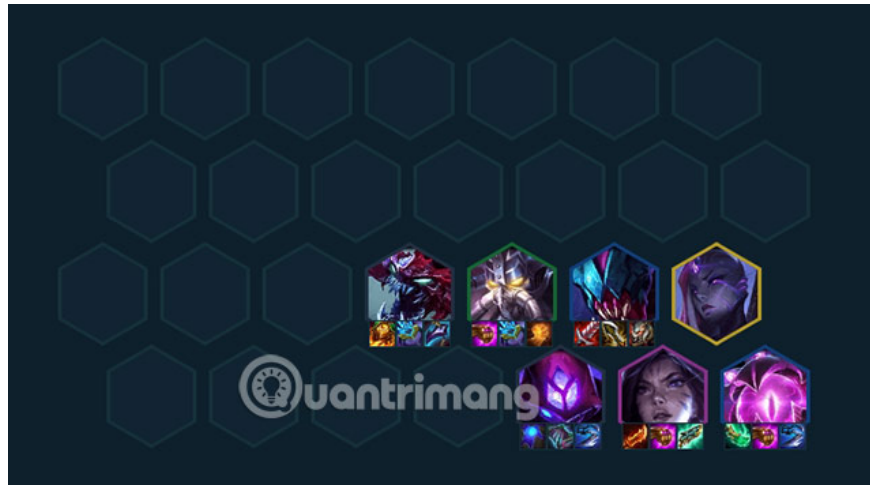


A little more difficult, if you have the Void Seal, you should throw it to an 8th champion in the team to get to 8 Void and get Baron Nashor. This 8th champion should be a damage-dealing champion like Yasuo because the tank line is now too full, not to mention Baron Nashor is also a good damage support and also a tank with strong health.



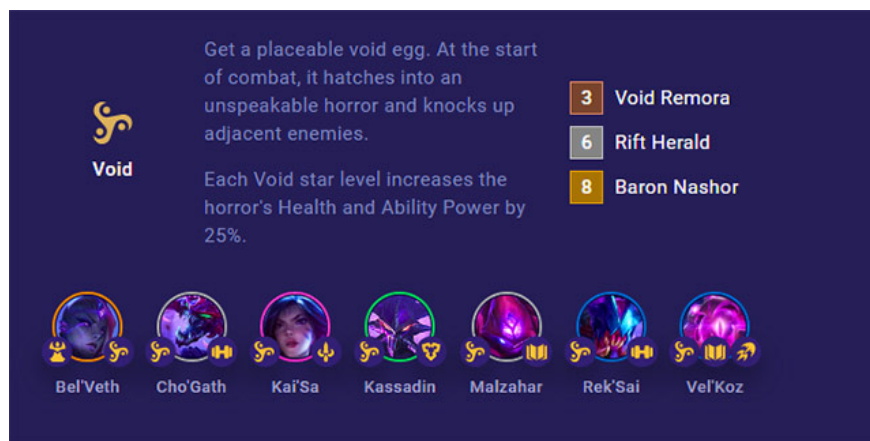
Match items for General Void

Tank items you can use for Kassadin and Cho'Gath, physical damage items for Rek'sai and Bel'Veth. And Malzahar, Kai'Sa and Vel'Koz will need magic damage items.



You can use equipment in a variety of ways for the Void squad, because the whole team can pawn items to help each other from low to high cost champions. So you don't have to worry about having too many items or specifying one type of item for champions that use magic damage or physical damage.

Void Generals TFT season 9



Cho'Gath – Void, Fighter

Skill: Deals magic damage to the adjacent enemy with the lowest health. If this kills them, Cho'Gath will devour them and permanently gain 45/50/60 max health.

Malzahar – Void, Mage

Skill: Opens two void portals near the current target. Destroys 34% of shields and deals magic damage to all enemies standing between the gates.

Kassadin – Void, Courageous

Skill: Gain shield for 4 seconds. Deals magic damage to enemies in a cone and applies a forbidden effect to them for 1.5/1.8/2 seconds. Forbidden Attack: Cannot move or attack, but can cast moves.

Rek'Sai – Void, Fighter

Skill: Rek'Sai bites and deals physical damage to the current target. If they are below 60% health, this damage will be converted to true damage and increased. If she kills the target, Rek'Sai rushes 1 cell to the side and grabs the nearby enemy champion, while restoring health.

Vel'Koz – Void, Multi-Spell Mage, Sorcerer

Skill: Fires a beam of plasma towards the current target, dealing magic damage to the first enemy hit. It then splits in two, dealing 50% less damage each time it passes through an enemy.

Kai'Sa – Void, Challenge

Skill: Dash away from all enemies, then fire 15/15/25 rounds through the 4 nearest enemies. Each projectile deals magical damage.

Bel'Veth - Queen, Void

Skill: Attacks the enemy with the lowest health within range x times. Each attack deals physical damage and 1% of the target's maximum health as true damage.

Void champions do not benefit from clan stats except for eggs that hatch support monsters according to each Void milestone. Void has the advantage of only stopping at 8 Void even though the break point is 3-6-8. Therefore, you only need to activate 1 more buff from **DTCL Technology Upgrade** season 9 to be able to reach 8 Void.



Void Generals also do not need to combine much with other generals, just need a full complement of Void Generals and you will have a full offensive and defensive squad. **Kai'Sa DTCL** season 9 is a staple that many gamers often choose even when not playing Void. **DTCL Challenger** Team is also her second stop if you have a lot of magic items.

Void is an easy squad to play in this season 9, they do not need to combine with many other clans although Void can easily team up with many different champions.
