

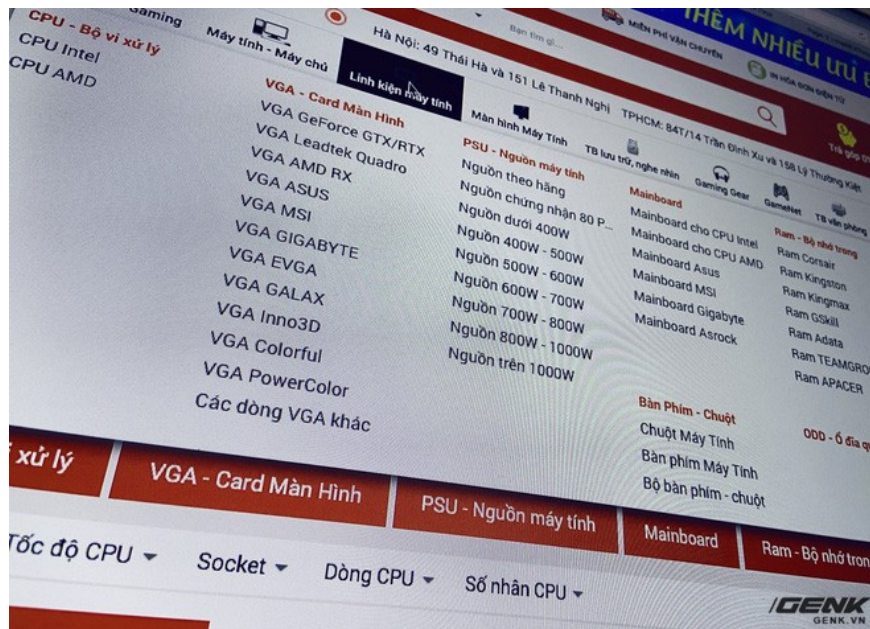
Buying a computer to work from home, why choose a laptop over a desktop?

Integrated everything, easy to use

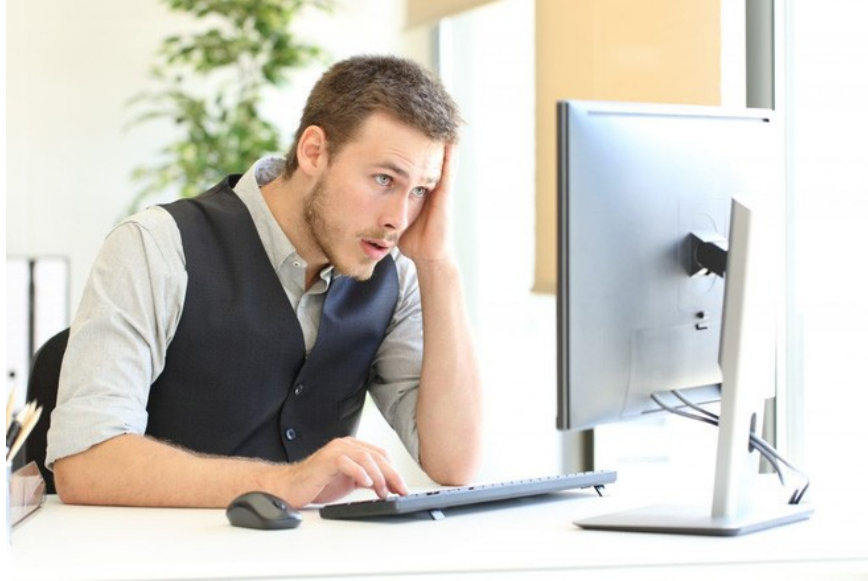
Laptop users can be comfortable in choosing positions and working positions

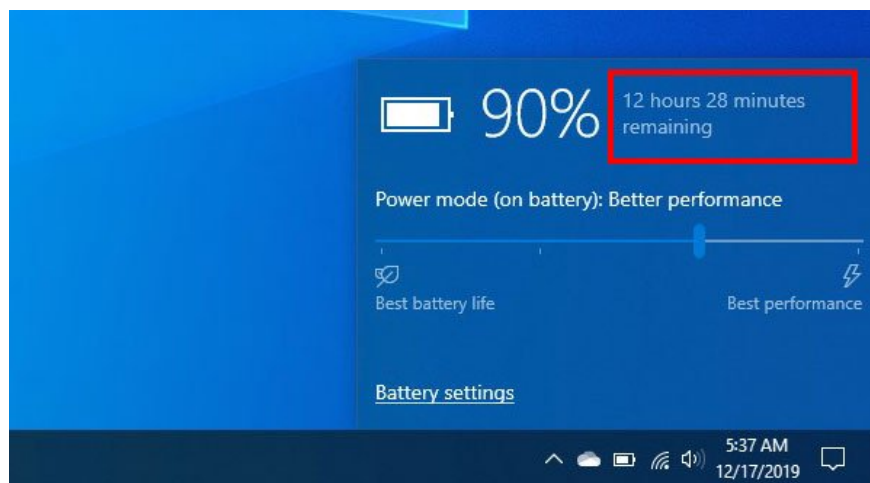
to worry.
