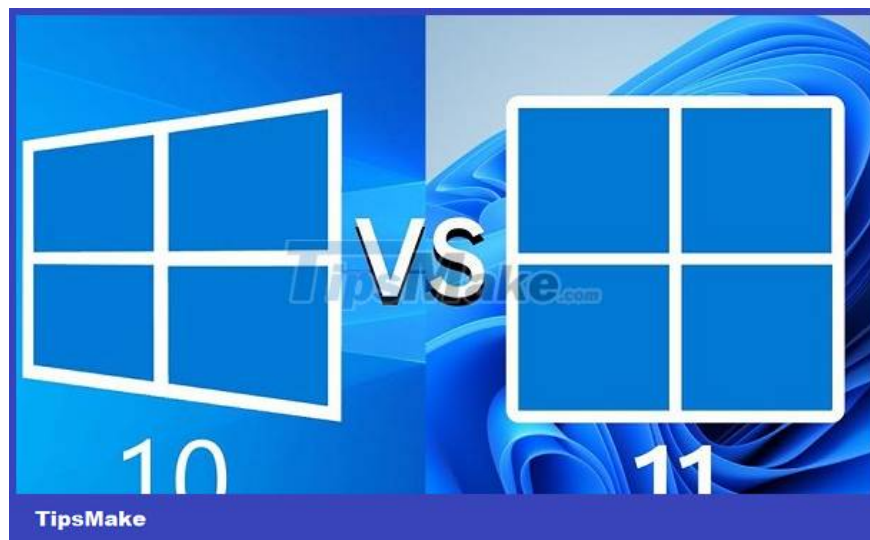


## Why can't open Realtek HD Audio Manager Win 10 + 11?

Normally when you turn on your computer, Realtek HD Audio Manager will automatically activate. But that's not always the case. It is possible that the computer does not have realtek hd audio manager due to the following reasons:

- 1: While using the computer, you accidentally disabled this feature. This is a fairly common case for people who are new to computers and make mistakes.
- 2: Not being able to open Realtek HD Audio Manager Win 10, 11 may also be because we have not updated the driver.

- 3: The situation of not being able to open Realtek HD Audio Manager Win 11 may also be due to a driver conflict and leading to an error.
- 4: Windows error is also the leading reason why users cannot open Realtek HD Audio Manager Win 10 + 11.



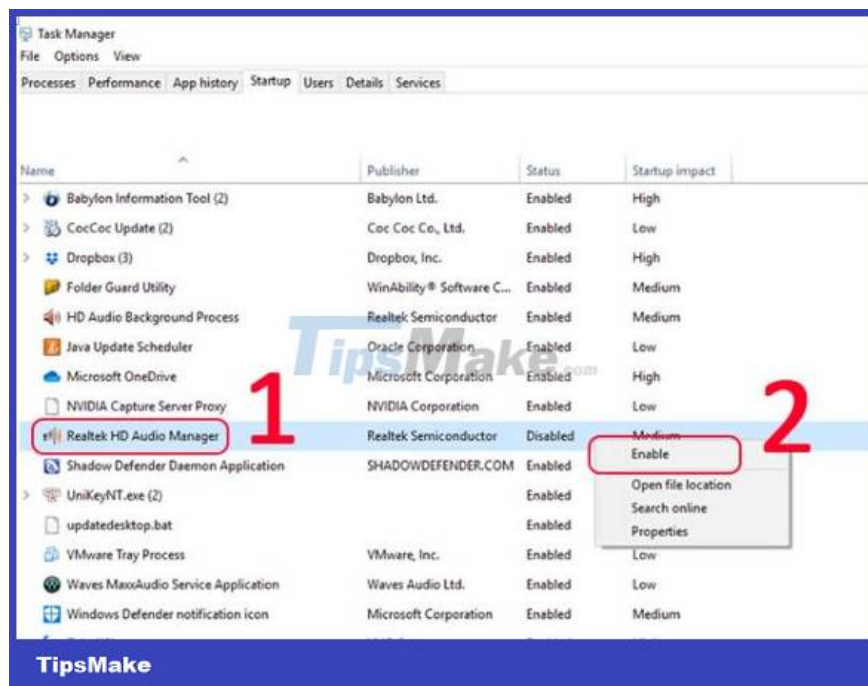
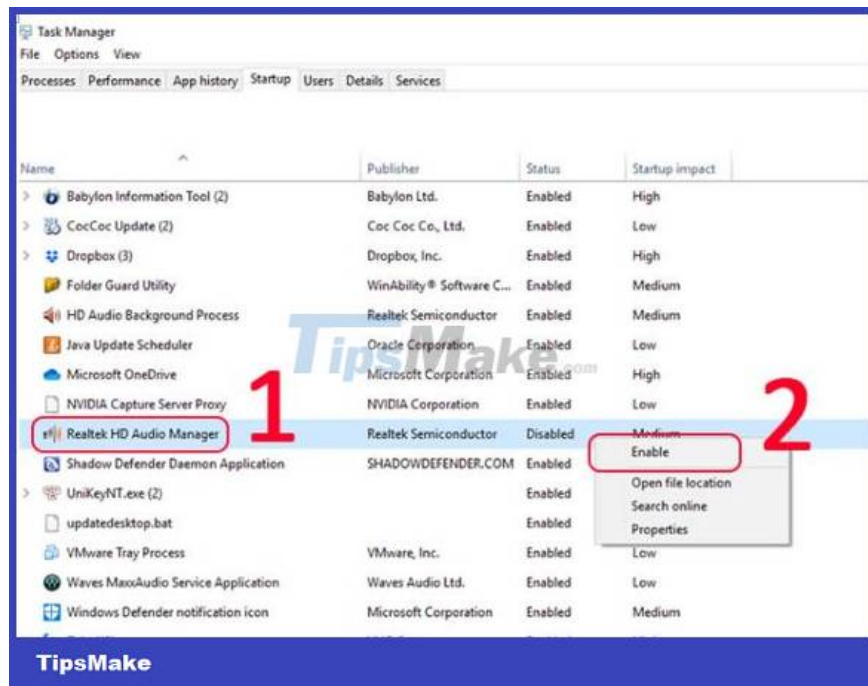
## Ways to fix when your computer cannot open Realtek HD Audio Manager

The situation of not being able to open Realtek HD Audio Manager is not a serious problem. When you encounter this situation, try the following methods immediately to see if the problem is fixed or not!

### 1: Enable Realtek HD Audio Manager on your computer

1. **Step 1** : On the desktop, right-click on the taskbar then click on **task manager** . Or you can also do it quickly with the keyboard shortcut **Ctrl + Shift + ESC** .

2. **Step 2** : Click on the startup tab then go to **Realtek HD Audio Manager**. If you see this item is disabled, right-click and select **enable** .



## 2: You can also try checking and updating the driver on your computer

1. **Step 1** : On the desktop, right-click on this PC and select **manage** . Then continue to select **device manager** . Or you can also do it quickly with the **Windows + X** key combination .
2. **Step 2** : Click on **sound, video and game controllers** , then right-click and select **Realtek Audio** . and click **update driver** .

3. **Step 3** : Click **Search automatically for drivers** > After the process is completed, select **close** .



### 3: Reinstall the driver

If you've done the two methods above but it still doesn't work, try uninstalling and reinstalling the driver on your computer. To do this, we do the following:

1. **Step 1** : Follow the instructions in the second method. But instead of selecting update driver, we will click **uninstall device** . The old driver will now be removed from your computer.
2. **Step 2** : Visit Realtek's website via the link **HERE** Then choose the version suitable for your computer. If your computer runs Windows 11 64bit, select realtek hd **audio manager windows 11 64-bit** and download it. (win 10 and 110 use the same driver)
3. **Step 3** : Click **I accept to the above** and then select **download this file** . You can also enter your email address to receive the download link via email. Then click **save file** .
4. **Step 4** : After downloading, open the file and select **next** . When the installation process is complete, click on **finish** .
