

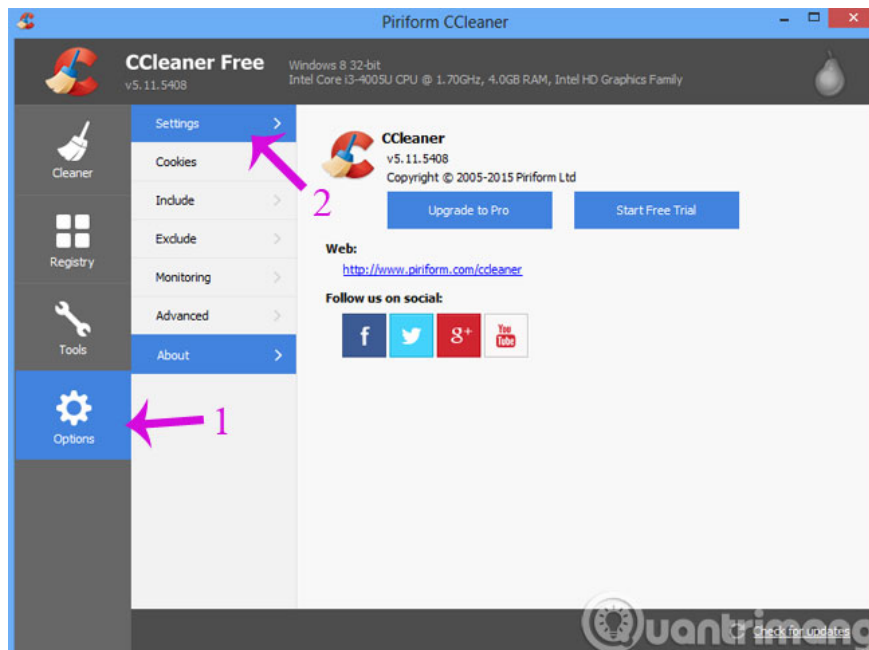
CCleaner setup starts the same system

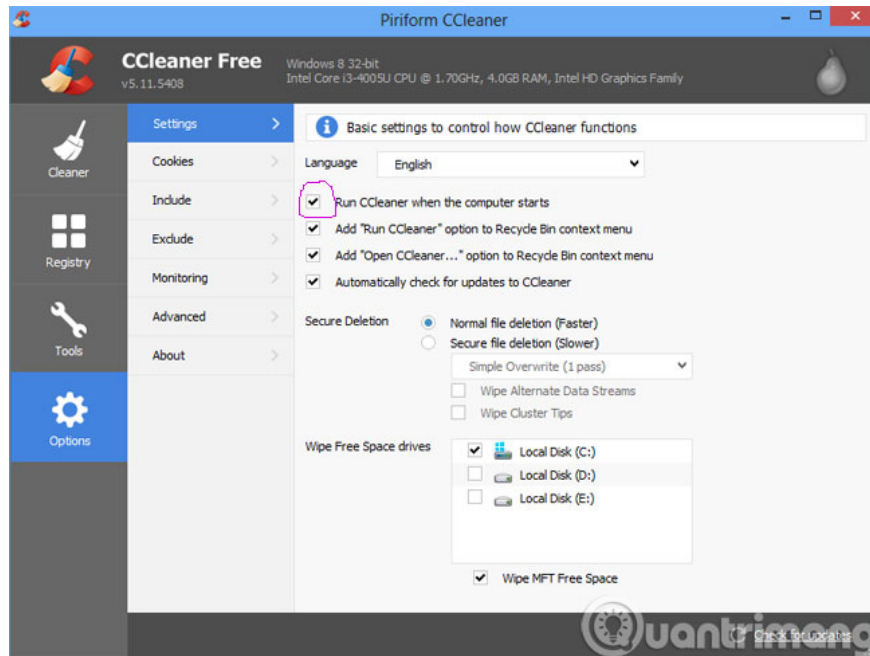

Step 1 : From the main interface of CCleaner, you press **Options** and then select **Settings**



Step 2 : At the setup window, check the **Run CCleaner when the computer starts** box .



So with just 2 very simple steps you have added CCleaner to the boot process of the system successfully. Very convenient, right?
