1. Applies to: Windows Server (Semi-Annual Channel), Windows Server 2016, Windows Server 2012 R2, Windows Server 2012.

The change command changes the Remote Desktop Session Host (rd Session Host) setting for login times, mapping COM port and installation mode.

## Note

In Windows Server 2008 R2, Terminal Services has been renamed to Remote Desktop Services.

## Change command syntax

```
change logon  
change port  
change user
```

## Change command parameter

Parameters Describe change logon Turn on or turn off login from the client session on the rd Session Host server or display the current login status. change port List or change COM port mapping for compatibility with MS-DOS applications. change user to change the installation mode for rd Session Host server.
