

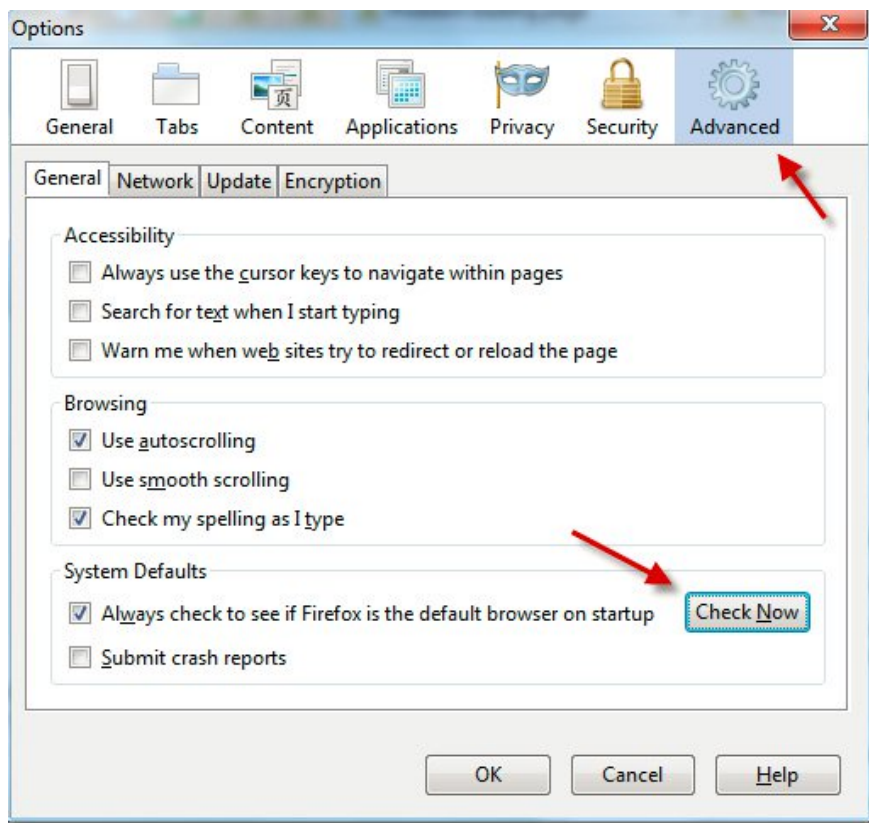
Change the default browser in Windows

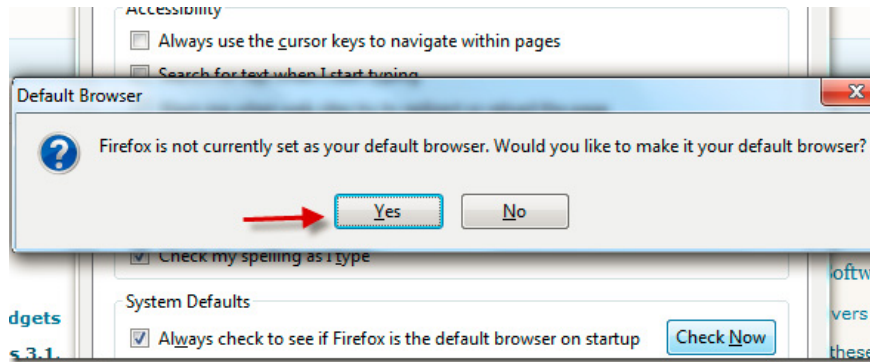

Here, we will see how to do with the three most popular browsers: **Firefox** , **Chrome** and **IE** .

Firefox:

First, start Firefox, open **Tools> Options> Advanced**. Here, you will see a box to select Firefox as the system's default browser:

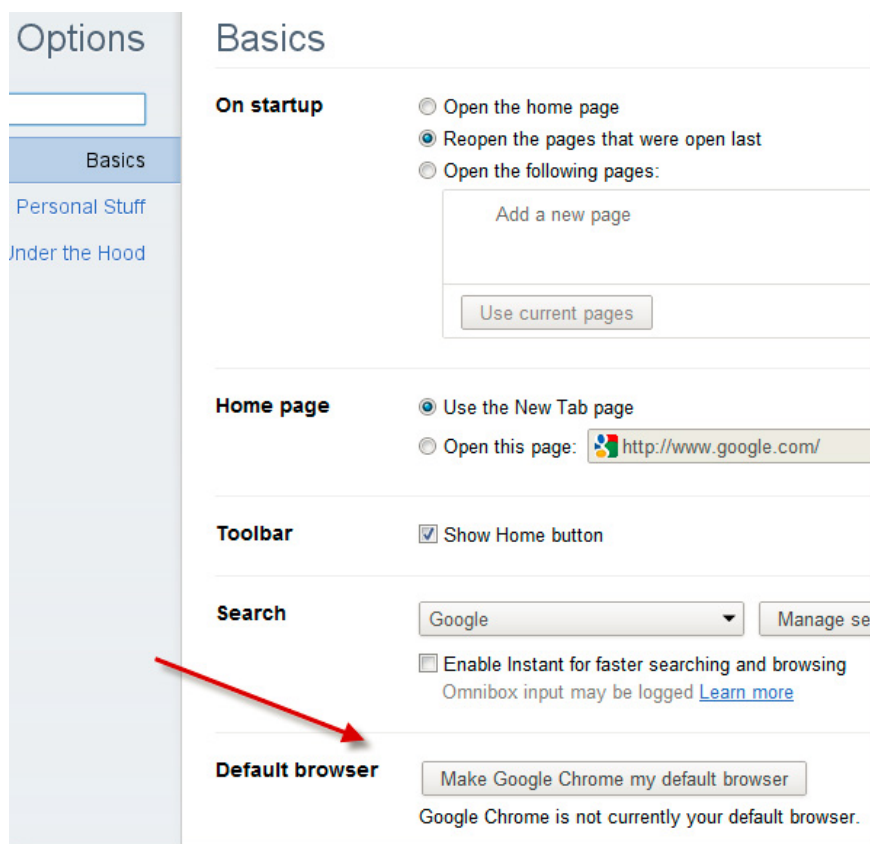


When you press the **Check now** button, a pop up window will appear and ask if you are sure you want to set up. Select **Yes** :



Chrome:

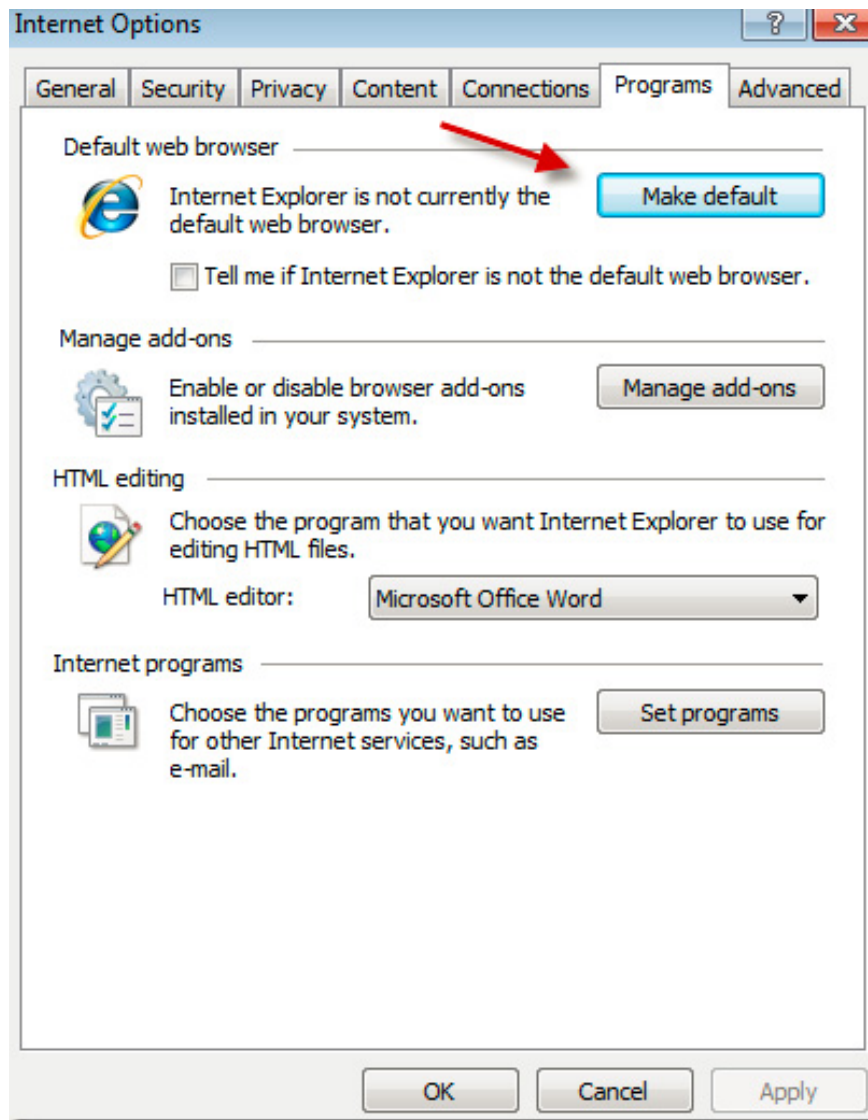
Same as above, after starting Chrome, you open **Options** and search by **Basics> Default browser**:



All you need to do here is click the **Make Google Chrome my default browser button**.

Internet Explorer:

No matter which version of IE you are using, the process remains unchanged. Open **Tools> Internet Options> Programs> Default web browser**:
