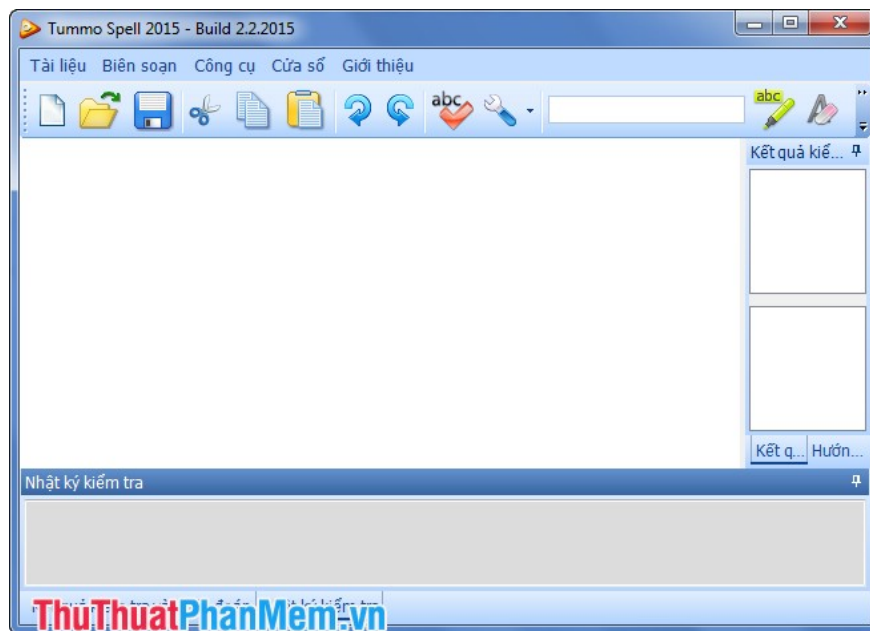

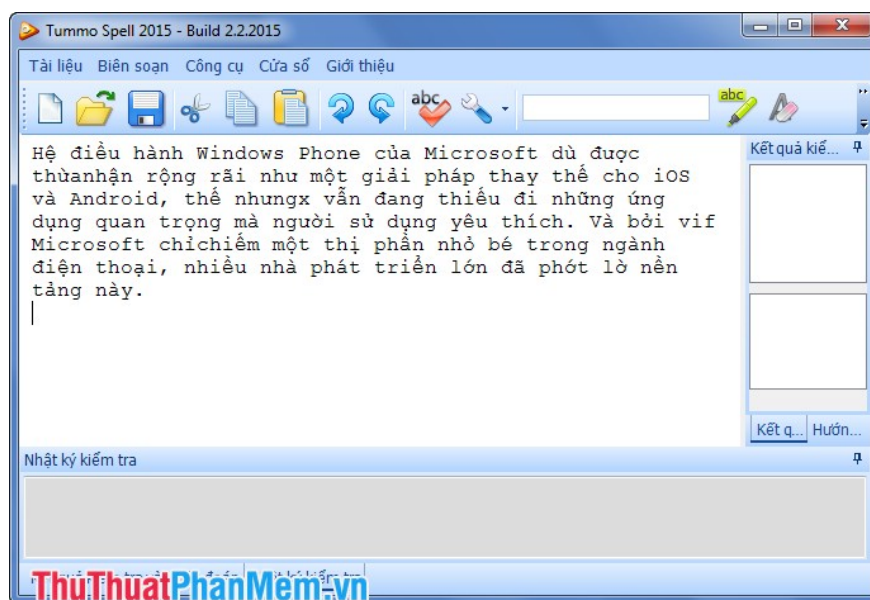

You choose the installation in the **Download** section at <http://tummosoft.com/2014/05/19/tummo-spell-2014-build-1-06-2014/>.

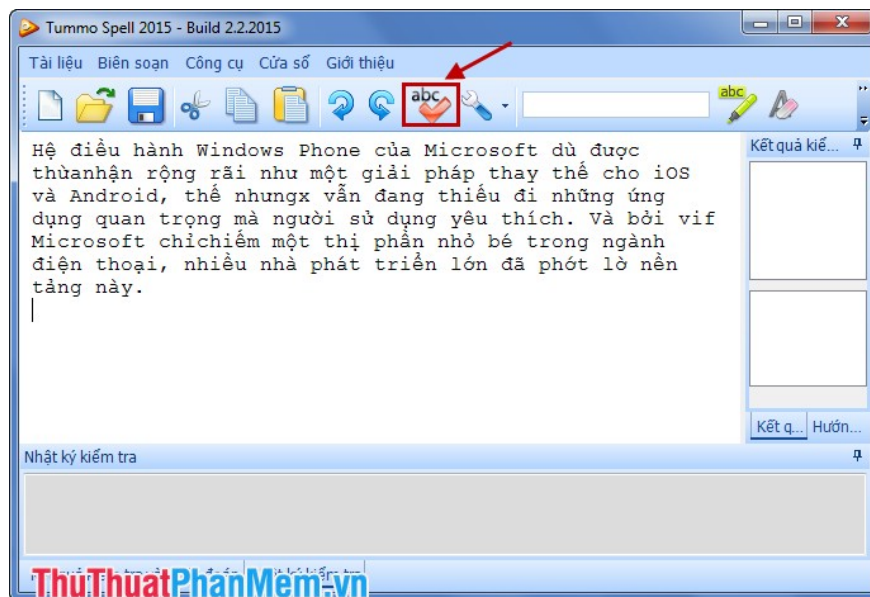
Step 2: After downloading and installing the software, you run Tummo Spell. The interface of the program is as follows:



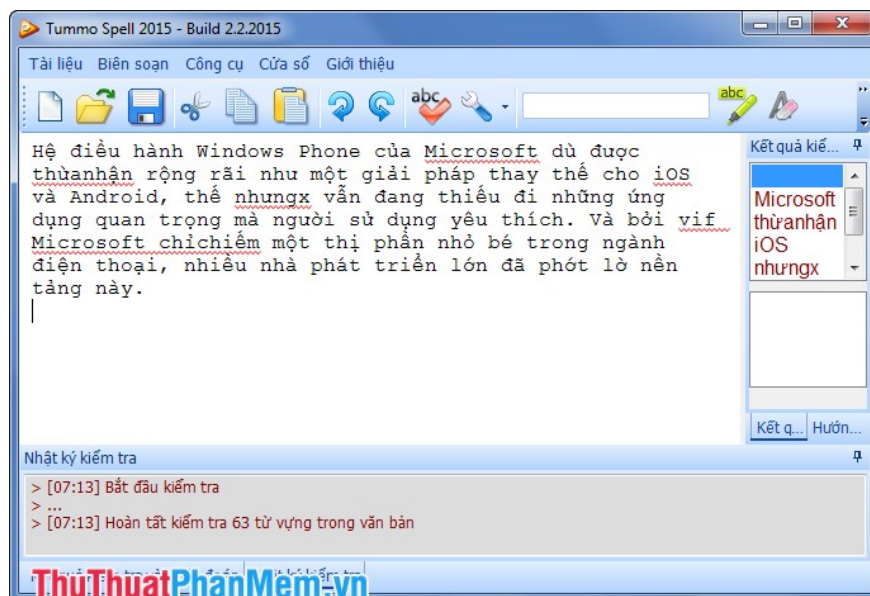
Step 3: Copy the text to be tested and paste in the space on the interface.
