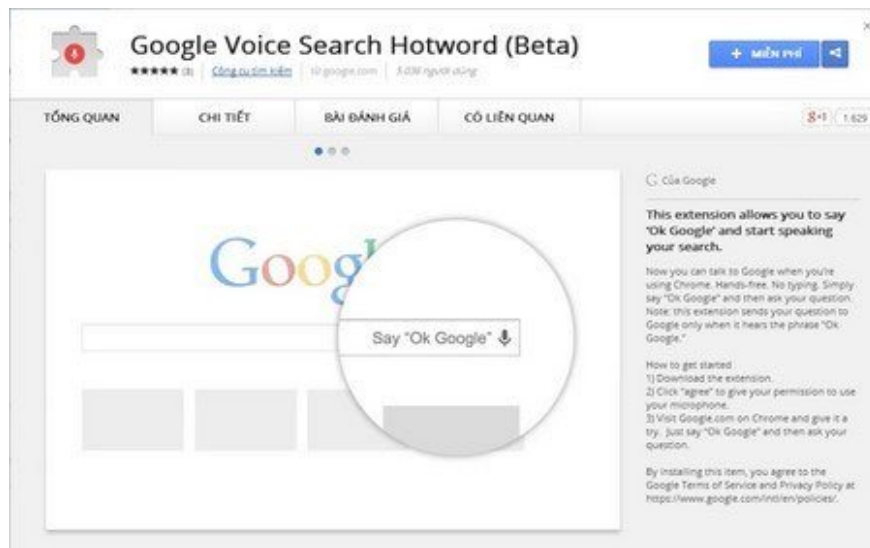


Chrome is about to allow voice search, no need to install an Extension

In addition, you can also use this feature to perform a certain task in the "recipe" form, such as scheduling an appointment .
