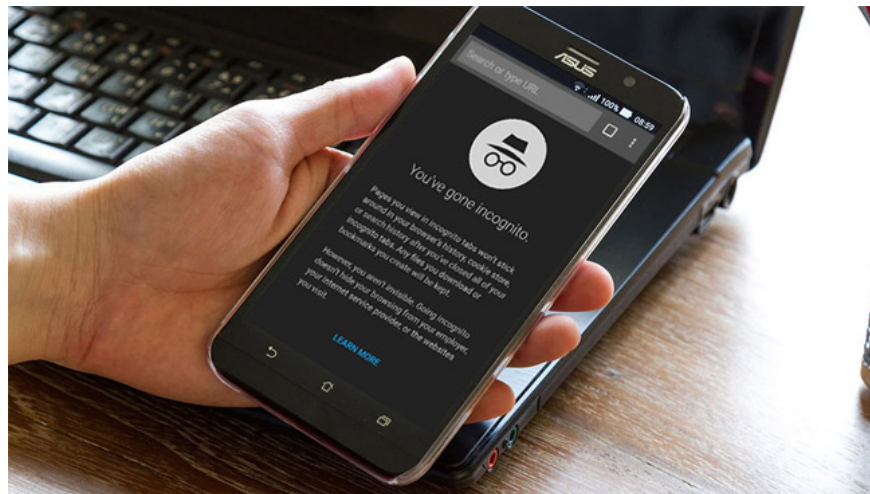


Chrome's incognito mode is not as discreet as you think

Even if you use incognito mode, the activity log in Chrome browser is still saved by Android devices in a record.

To remove traces after using a browser such as browsing history, cookies or other data, many people often open Incognito Mode on Google Chrome when surfing the web. But in fact on the Chrome version for mobile, this incognito mode is not really safe as we think, some information when browsing the web is still collected.

Specifically, the activity log on the user's Chrome browser is still saved by Android devices in a record.



You can access and view this recording details via some applications such as Activity Launcher or Nova Launcher. A user with the nickname Mas_Zeta shared on the Reddit discussion page that if you play videos on Chrome, whether it's private or not, the Notification Log will display some basic information such as titles or messages. believe about that video.

You can use another browser to secure your information, such as Firefox Focus. Or to delete the information that the Notification Log has saved by restarting the device after browsing the web.
