'Today, on the first day of the birthday week, we officially announce that Cloudflare will not attack customers anymore, no matter how big the DDoS attack scale is and no matter which package they use,' Prince said. 'Unlike any previous practice in the industry, we will not make your bill up.'

'We call this Unmetered Mitigation', coming from the idea that you don't have to pay extra for protection. ' Cloudflare also posted two blog posts explaining how they use No Scrubs and Gatebot technology to provide DDoS unlimited protection.
