Clusterduck is a science game based on genetics. Participating in the game, the player must collect and breed ducks together to create the best combination of genes.

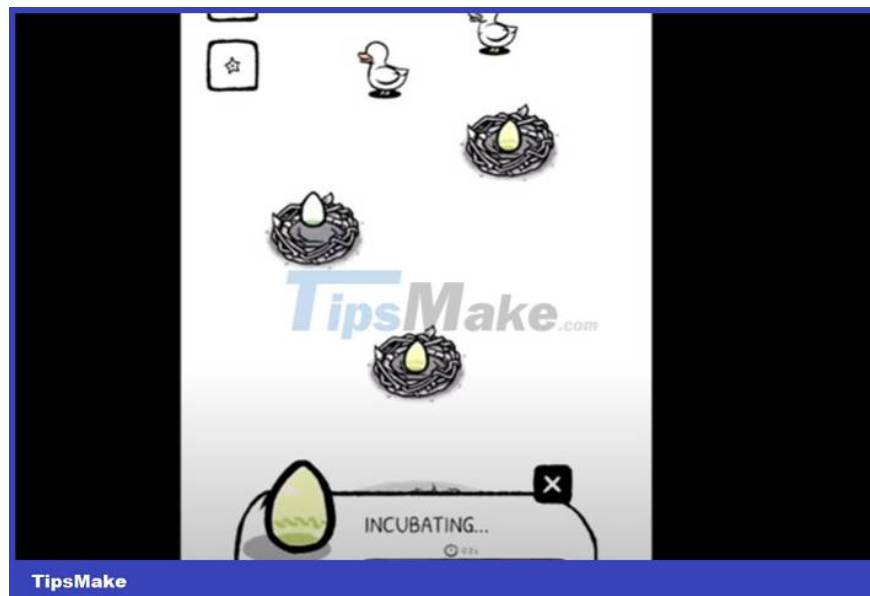

Tips for playing Clusterduck

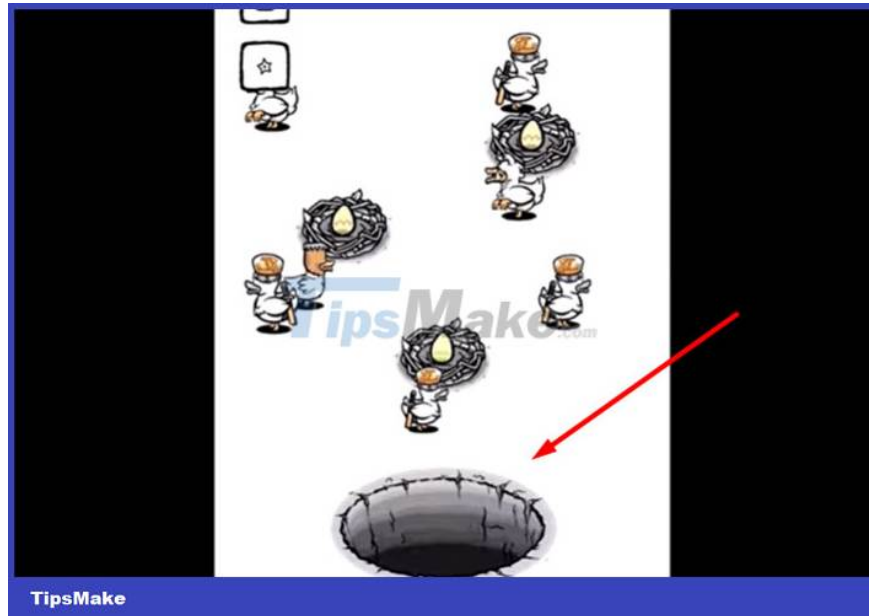
Watch ads to hatch eggs faster

At the beginning of the game, there will be 3 ducks and they will spawn more ducks in the future. Clusterduck has many different rare and exotic duck species. They are divided into categories like Ducky Duck, Neighborhood, Wrong Species, Myth & Legend, Duck Dimension,. Rare eggs take longer to hatch than regular eggs.



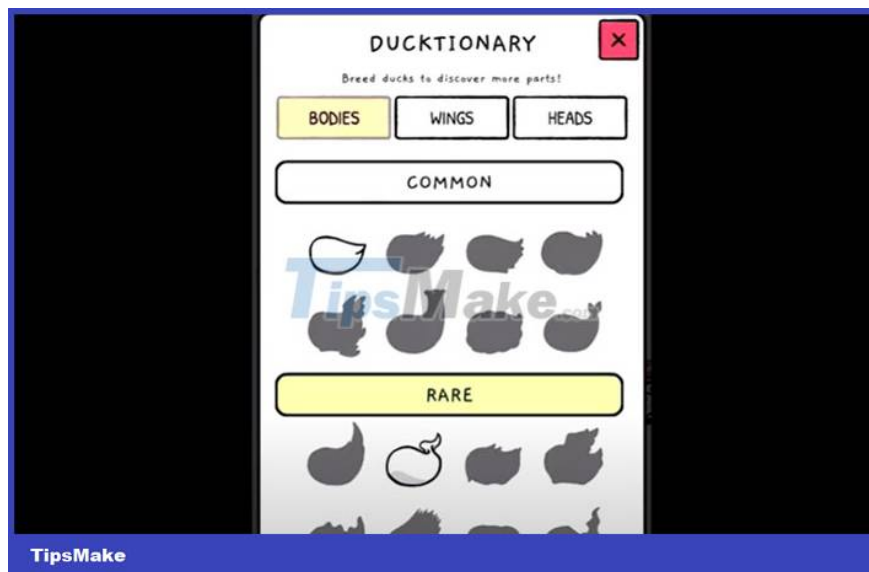
In the meantime, gamers can watch ads to reduce incubation time and collect rare ducks so they can continue to breed more rare ducks in Clusterduck.

Remove unwanted duck



Clusterduck only allows 25 ducks in the yard to work at a time. So, if you want to own the most exotic, unique, rare ducks and get the maximum score, the player needs to eliminate a few ducks to maintain the required number. Get rid of unwanted, common, unhelpful ducks for pitting and keep the best ones in the yard.

Collect all the parts of the duck



Every time you hatch rare eggs, the player will get different duck parts such as head, body, tail, wings,. Try and collect all the duck parts because they will be useful. useful in the game later. Players can check all the duck parts they have collected so far in the Ducktionary section of Clusterduck.

Keep more ducks or hatch more ducks

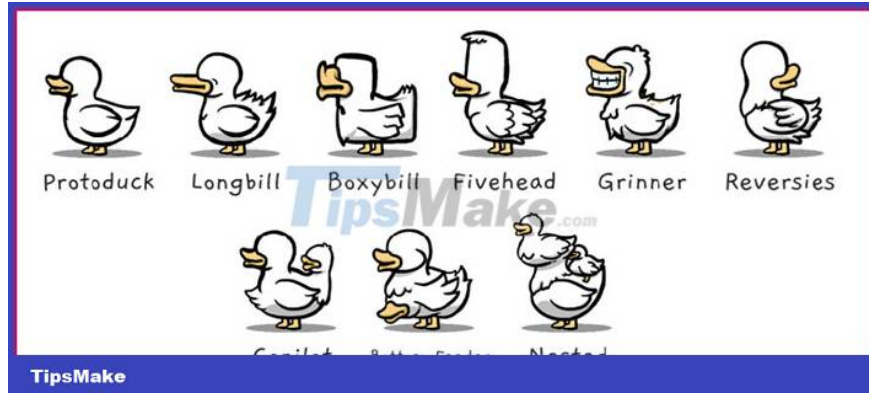
The usual limit per field is 25 ducks, but players can completely increase the number of ducks on the field from in-game purchases. Buying space will help the player incubate more eggs and hold more ducks at once, by

paying real-world money to level up faster in the game.

This last tip is completely optional, anyone can skip it and grow at the normal rate of Clusterduck.
