

How to Grow Cocoa Beans in Minecraft

1. Where Do Cocoa Beans Appear In Minecraft?



Java Edition

1. Cacao beans occur naturally in rainforests, bamboo forests, and scattered forests.
2. They exist as cocoa pods that grow on small natural forest trees.

Number of seeds obtained:

1. Small and medium fruit ? 1 cocoa bean
2. Large fruit ? 3 cocoa beans

Tools:

1. **An axe** is the preferred tool for breaking, but you can also use your hands or any other tool.

Bedrock Edition

In addition to the above method, Bedrock Edition also has additional methods:

1. Open **loot bonus chest**
2. Fishing in jungle, bamboo, and scattered forest biomes
3. **Dealing with wandering traders**

So, cocoa beans are easier to find for Bedrock players, but Java is not too difficult to collect either.

2. How to grow Cocoa Beans in Minecraft



You cannot grow cocoa beans on soil, grass, or regular wood. Only **jungle wood** will work.

How to grow:

1. Pick cocoa beans in hand.
2. Press **the side of a jungle tree or stripped jungle log** .
3. Small green cocoa pods will appear.

The process of growing up

1. Small fruit ? Medium fruit light brown
2. Medium fruit ? Large dark brown fruit, when broken will yield **3 cocoa beans**

Accelerate growth

1. Use **bone meal** to help cocoa pods grow faster.

2. One time bone meal ? fruit advances to next stage
3. Here is a quick way to build an **efficient cocoa bean farm** in Minecraft.

3. What Are Cocoa Beans Used For In Minecraft?



3.1 Brown Dye

1. **Java Edition:** Convert cocoa beans to **brown dye** in the crafting grid (1 bean ? 1 dye)
2. **Bedrock Edition:** Cocoa beans used directly as brown dye without conversion

3.2 Uses in crafting

1. **Cocoa beans are an ingredient in cookie** recipes.
2. Can be combined with other ingredients to color objects.



3.3 Making compost

1. Cocoa beans can be put into a **composter**.
2. Increase **compost layer** with 65% probability

4. Quick Harvest Tips and Cocoa Bean Farms

1. Create **cocoa bean fields** on artificial jungle trees for continuous harvesting
2. Use **bone meal** to shorten the maturity time
3. Combine with other plants to get **many dye colors for decoration or processing**.
