## Queen Elizabeth I

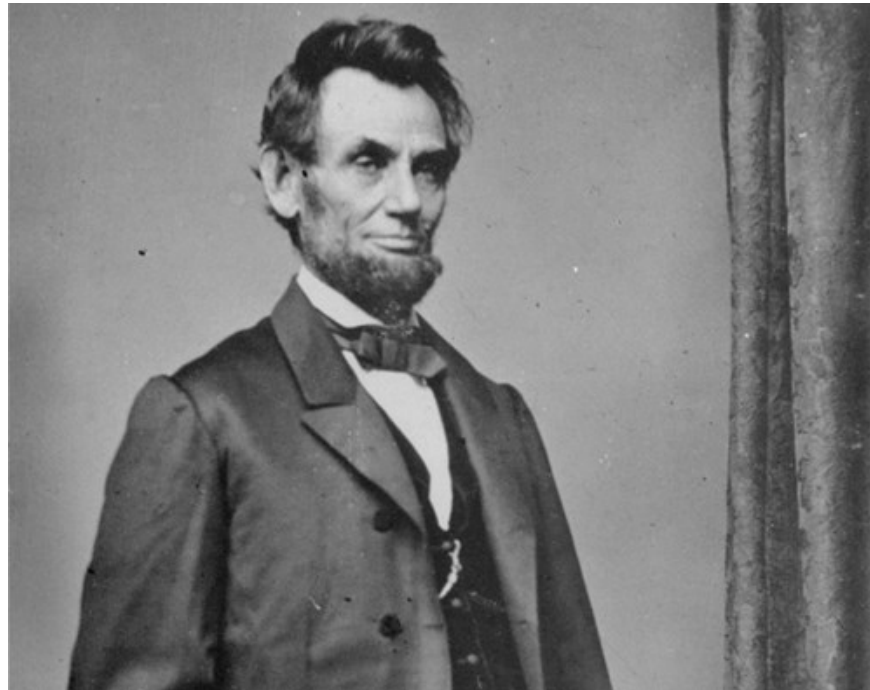


Queen Elizabeth I was a wise, calm, prestigious monarch, she reigned the United Kingdom from November 17, 1558 until her death - March 24, 1603.
