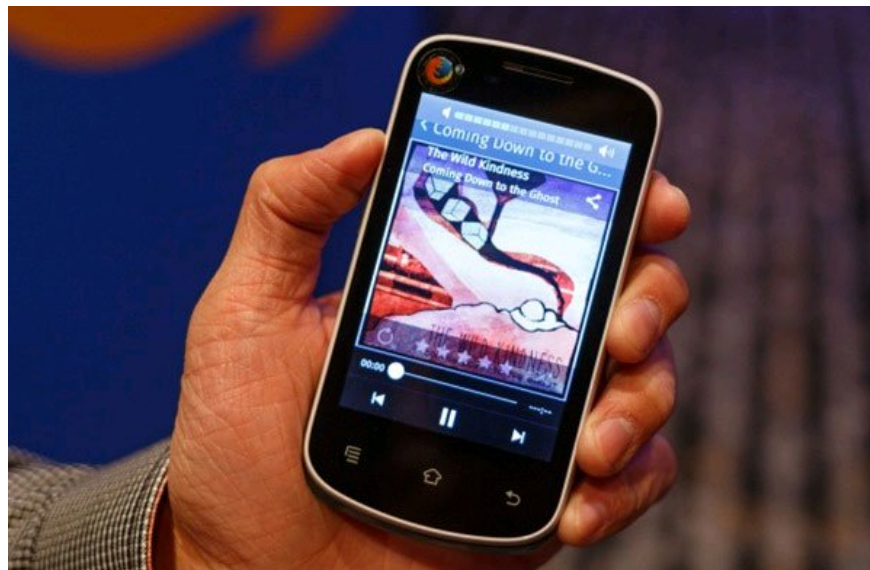


Coming soon Firefox OS smartphone costs only 550 thousand dong

Spreadtrum is a well-known mobile phone manufacturer, but with the implementation of Mozilla's plan, Spreadtrum will expand its brand. The two companies plan to release smartphones with the following criteria: providing smartphones to consumers at the lowest price possible.

The new smartphone will use the Cortex A5 SC6821 processor produced by Spreadtrum itself. This processor does not support 4G LTE network but only supports WCDMA and EDGE networks. Even SC6821 doesn't have WiFi, Bluetooth, camera or FM Radio. As a super cheap smartphone, this device only has a 3.5-inch touch screen.

Although the specifications are not impressive, however, the price of 25 USD, Mozilla's smartphone and Spreadtrum will likely be welcomed by the emerging market. If released in Vietnam, we can choose this product to replace popular phones to meet the basic needs of listening, texting and Internet access.
