

# Common computer errors and how to fix them quickly.

## Common errors and how to fix them

### *Error 404: Not Found*

This is arguably the most common error you'll encounter while using a computer. It occurs when your computer can't find a server and usually appears in your internet browser window. Each website typically displays a different 404 error message, often with content like: "404 Error", "Page cannot be displayed", "Internet Explorer cannot display the webpage", "404: Not Found", "The page cannot be found", "Error 404: NOT FOUND", "HTTP 404 - File not found", "Not Found".



*How to fix it:*

Click refresh/reload in your browser window or re-enter the URL in the address bar. Sometimes this error appears even when there's no actual system problem, so performing these steps to reload the webpage may resolve the issue.

Check the URL address; it might be due to a misspelled URL or a link you clicked leading to the wrong address. Make sure there are no errors in the path.

*Error 500: Internal Server Error*

Similar to other errors, the 500: Internal Server Error also appears in the browser window during web browsing due to a connection error with the server. The message about the "500 Internal Server Error" can vary from website to website. Often, we will encounter this error in the following format: "500: Internal Server Error", "HTTP Error 500 - Internal Server Error", "500 Error".



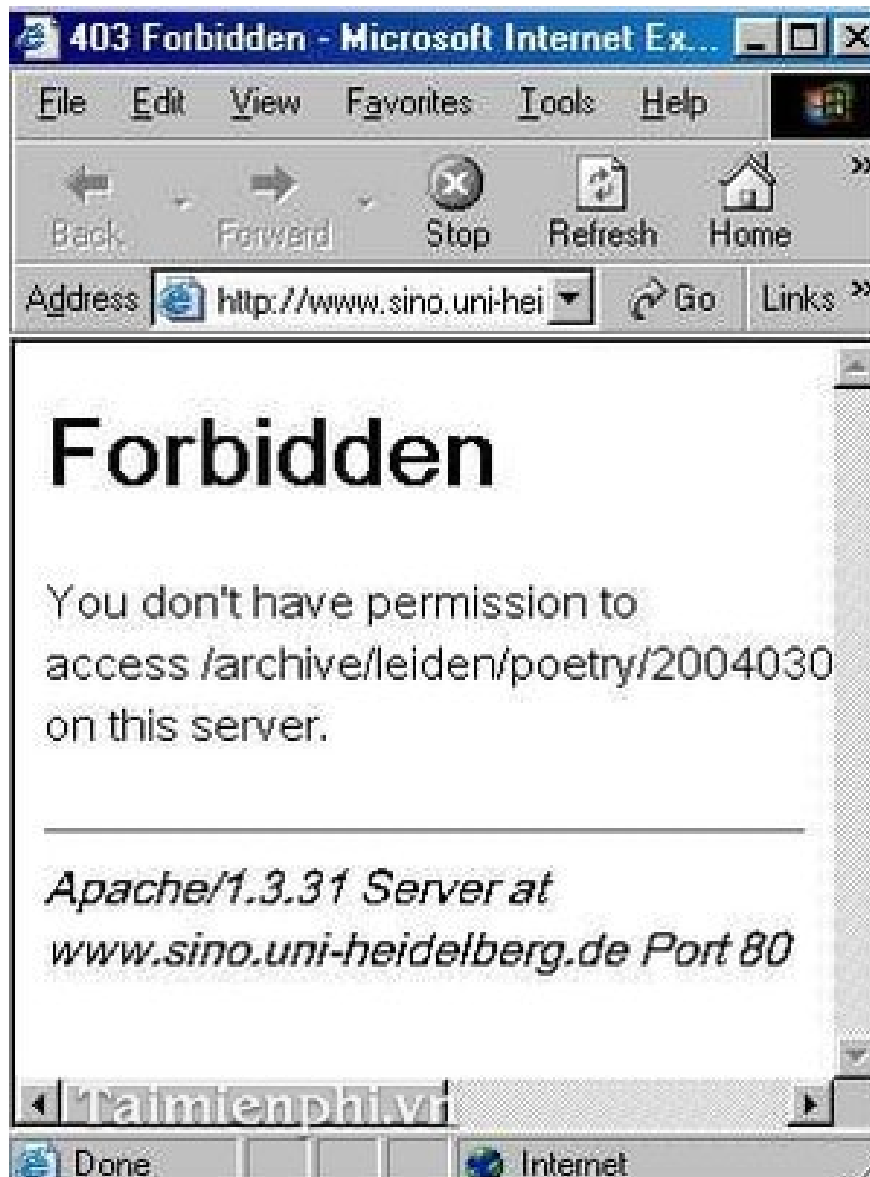
*How to fix it:*

Click the refresh/reload button in your browser window or re-enter the URL. Since the 500 Internet Server Error is often temporary, reloading the page several times to a previous point may improve the situation.

If that doesn't work, please contact the website owner via email to find out the status.

*Error 403: Forbidden*

Similar to the two errors above, this error is also commonly encountered when browsing websites and is due to accessing blocked websites.



*How to fix it:*

This error is most often caused by an incorrect URL. Please check and make sure your URL is correct. Sometimes, even if the website is accessed correctly, a 403 Forbidden error may be due to some misunderstanding.

Accessing the website is not within your authority.

*Error 503 Service Unavailable*

This error usually occurs when the website is down.



If you encounter this error, you should return to other websites or wait for the server to be back online before accessing the website again.

Several errors can affect your user experience, from system freezes and blue screen errors to internet connection problems. To fix them, you need to identify the cause and apply appropriate solutions. Updating drivers, checking hardware, and optimizing the system can help minimize these errors. If the problem persists, you should refer to software troubleshooting guides, reinstall Windows, or use automatic troubleshooting tools to ensure your computer runs smoothly.
