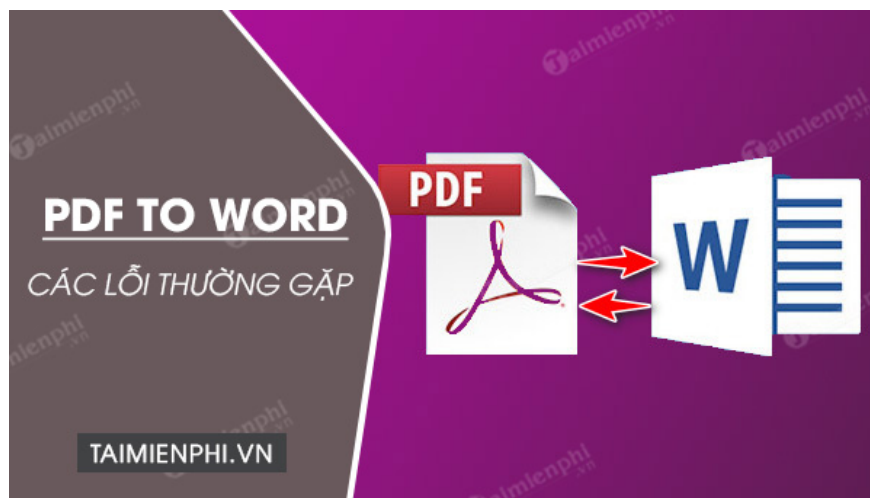


Common errors when converting PDF to Word files

Common errors when converting PDF to Word files

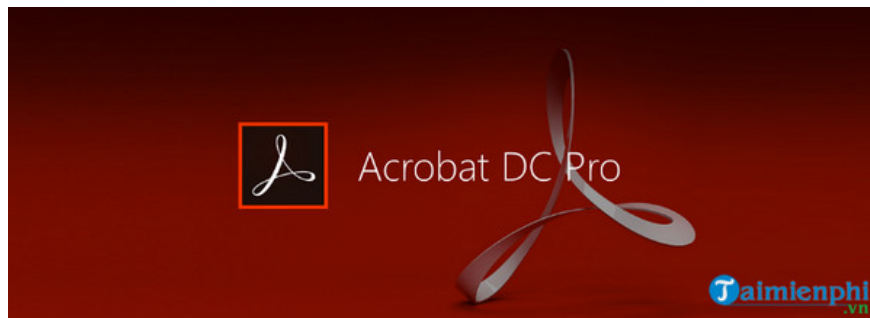
1. Error "Sorry we're having trouble converting your PDF to a Word document"

There are several reasons why you might encounter the error "Sorry we're having trouble converting your PDF to a Word document" when converting a PDF file to Word. To fix this error, you can refer to some of the troubleshooting methods below:



Method 1: Download the latest version of Adobe Acrobat

If you're using an older version of Adobe Acrobat and encountering errors during the PDF to Word conversion process, the first solution is to download and install the latest version of the software, then proceed to convert the PDF to Word and see if the error persists.

Method 2: Preserve the original file format.

In some cases, PDF readers may replace missing fonts with other fonts, causing errors.

To fix this error, follow these steps:

Step 1: Open Acrobat, then find and click **Edit => Preferences**.

Step 2: Access the **Convert from PDF** section and select the Word document.

Step 3: Click **Edit settings => Retain Page Layout** .

Step 4 : Click **OK**.

Step 5: Close and reopen Acrobat.

Finally, check if the error "Sorry we're having trouble converting your PDF to a Word document" still persists.

2. "File conversion" error

The "file conversion" error is a common error that often occurs when converting PDF files to Word using Adobe Acrobat.

To fix this error:

Make sure you are using a supported web browser. See the Adobe Acrobat PDF Export system requirements for more information.

- Make sure you are using a supported web browser. Supported browsers on Windows 10 include Internet Explorer 11, Microsoft Edge, Firefox, or Chrome. On macOS v10.12 and earlier versions, supported browsers include Safari 11 or older, Firefox, and Chrome.

- Clear your browser's cache, then try converting the PDF file to Word again to see if the error persists.

- Make sure you have disabled any firewall/proxy settings that restrict internet upload access.

- Try using a different browser.

- Ensure the PDF file you are converting is under 100MB, does not contain many different fonts and images, etc.

3. Error converting PDF to Word: Text cannot be edited.
