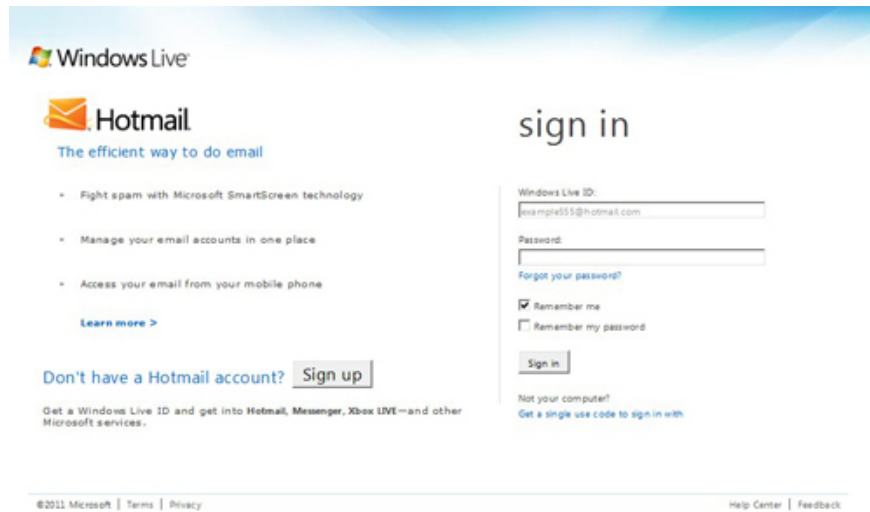
That way of thinking makes Microsoft image much worse when the names like Google and Linux still come up with completely free applications.

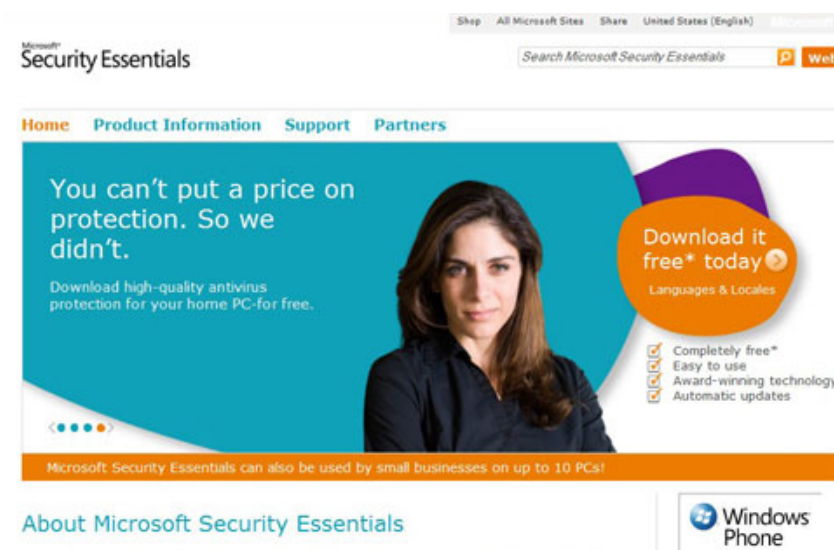
